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
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#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### STATE-LEVEL RESULTS

The graduation rate for Rhode Island public students is at its highest ever. In the class of 2016, 85.3% of students completed high school within four years, an increase of 2% over 2015. The rate increased or remained the same across all ethnic groups and both genders. Rhode Island students with disabilities saw an increase of 1.5% from last year. English Learners had a decrease of 0.4%.

### **SCHOOL-LEVEL RESULTS**

Across the state, 31 high schools—more than half of RI public high schools—graduated 90% or more of their students in four years. Fourteen high schools graduated over 95% of their students in four years.

Three high schools had greater than 10 percentage point increases in four-year graduation rates compared to last year (2015):

- Blackstone Academy Charter School (17.5%)
- The Greene School (17.5%)
- Dr. Jorge Alvarez High School (10.1%)

In addition, four schools' 4-year graduation rates increased by over 20 percentage points in the past five years, from the class of 2011 to the class of 2016:

- NEL/CPS Construction Career Academy (28%)
- William E. Tolman Senior High School (23%)
- Providence Career and Technical Academy (22%)
- Cranston High School East (22%)

# **APPENDICES**

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#### APPENDIX A

#### **Four-Year Graduation Rate**

A four-year graduation rate was calculated for each graduating class. The graduation rate yields the percentage of students who enrolled in the 9th grade for the first time and graduated from high school four years later. To calculate the four-year graduation rate, RIDE tracks an *Adjusted Cohort*<sup>4</sup> of students from 9th grade through high school and then divides the number of students who graduate within four years by the total number in the cohort. In other words, the rate provides the percentage of the cohort that graduates in four years or fewer.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The "Adjusted Cohort" of students includes those who enter ninth grade for the <u>first time</u> plus transfers *in* and minus transfers *out* as they progress through high school toward graduation.

#### APPENDIX B

## "Minimum Cell Size" Reporting Policy

RIDE Policy on minimum cell size for reporting data stipulates that if the number of students is less than 10 for any group(s) or for any school- and district-level reporting or if a percentage is less than 1%, then data must be suppressed in public reports to ensure confidentiality of individual student results and to discourage generalizations about school performance based on very small populations. Throughout this report, empty cells indicate that the number of students included in calculations was less than 10 or the percentage was less than 1%.



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
