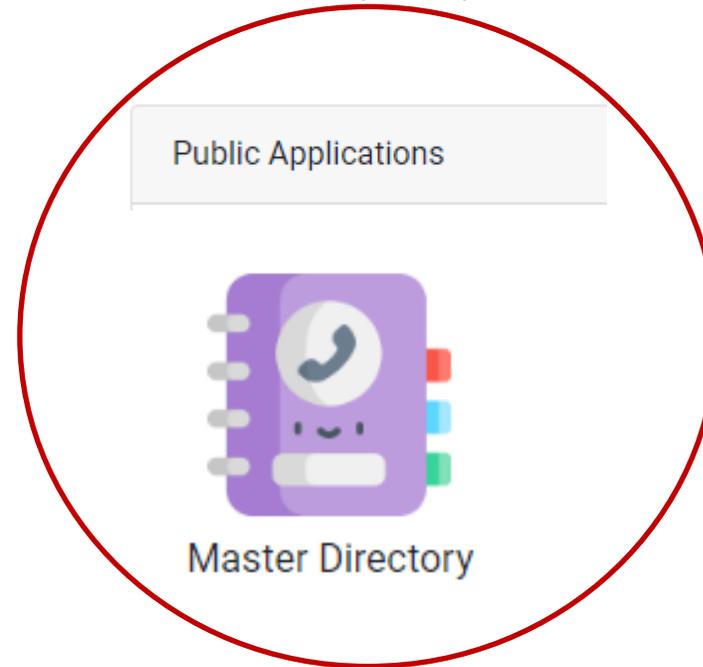
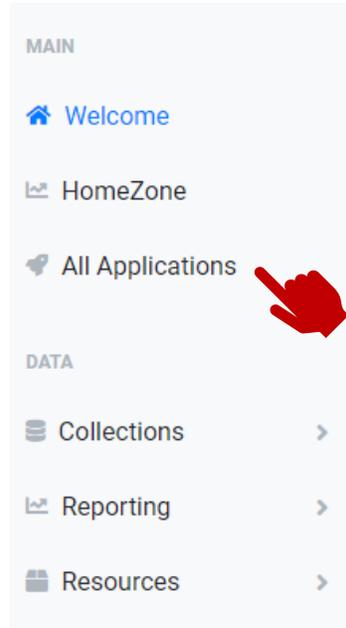
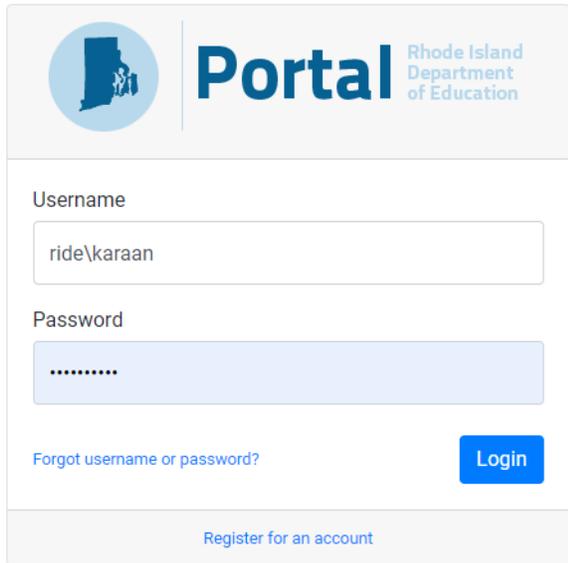
# Registration and Enrollment Reminders

# Accommodations Reminders

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- According to the most recent analysis of accommodations data in **PearsonAccess<sup>next</sup>**, we have identified students who are receiving RICAS ELA accommodations that they are not eligible for.
- As you prepare for RICAS ELA, please run a **PNP report** to ensure that accommodation assignments are accurate.
- Students who complete a test with accommodations that they are not eligible for **may have their results invalidated for accountability.**
- RIDE will be conducting this analysis once testing is completed as well, to determine if any test results will be invalidated.

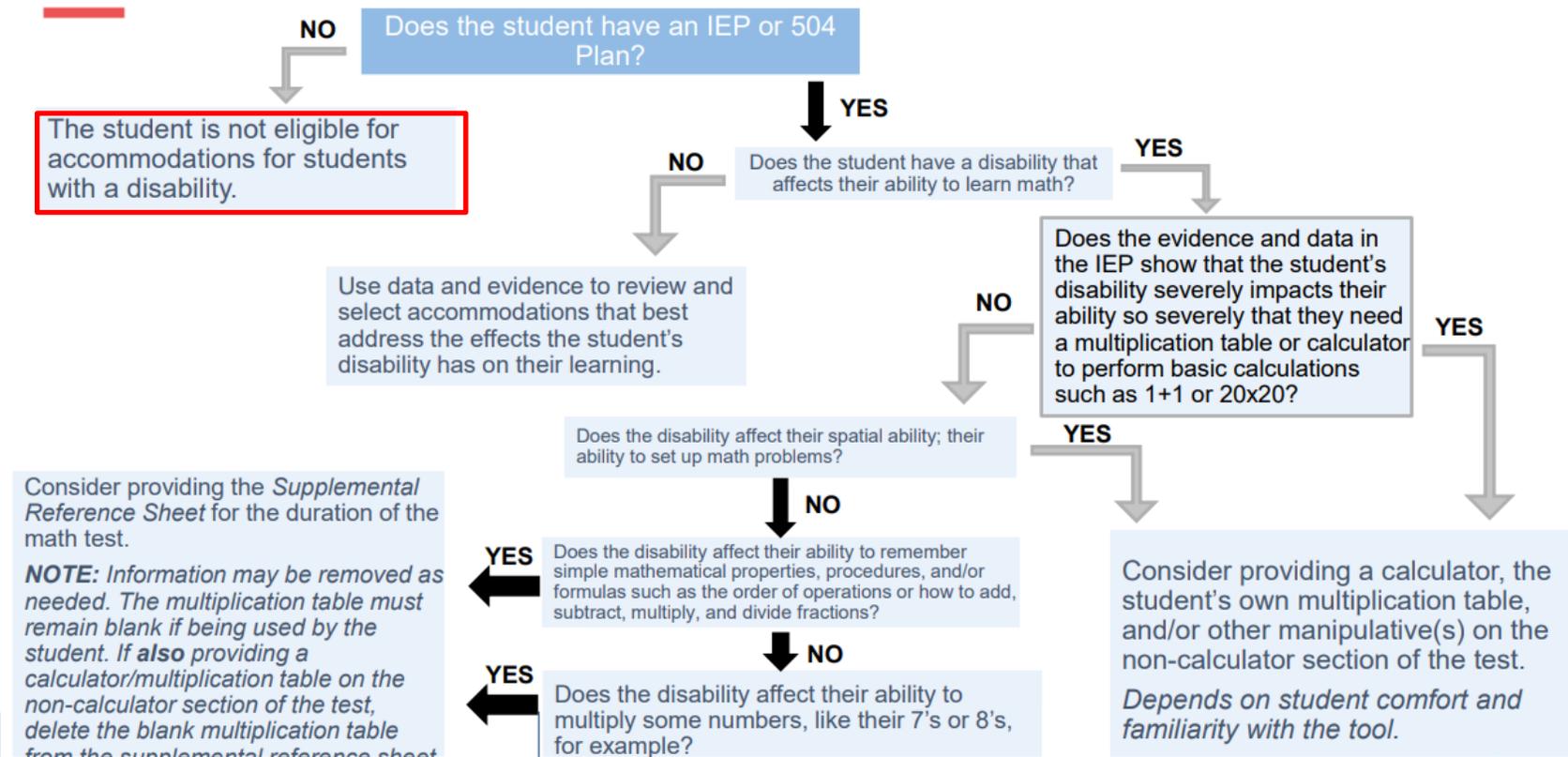

# Important Bluebook Update

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A new version of Bluebook is being released for spring testing!

- College Board will also [post the release notes to the Bluebook webpage](#) and publish banners on the website pointing people to the release notes.
- For this routine release, Bluebook will auto-update unless blocked when students open it on their testing device. In some cases, districts/schools may need to manually update Bluebook if auto-update is not permitted.

# College Board TDTK is OPEN

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## Student Registration Reminders:

- RIDE registers students by passing data files to College Board nightly.
  - Updates/changes to student information *cannot be made in TDTK*.
  - Changes must be made in the district Student Information System, come to RIDE, then be passed again to College Board.
  - *Changes may take from 24 to 48hours before they can be seen in TDTK.*

## User Accounts:

- Coordinators will receive an email. SAT, PSAT 10 Coordinators are responsible for creating teacher (proctor) and other coordinator accounts.
  - Proctor accounts will need to be created for both SAT and PSAT 10 testing in TDTK.

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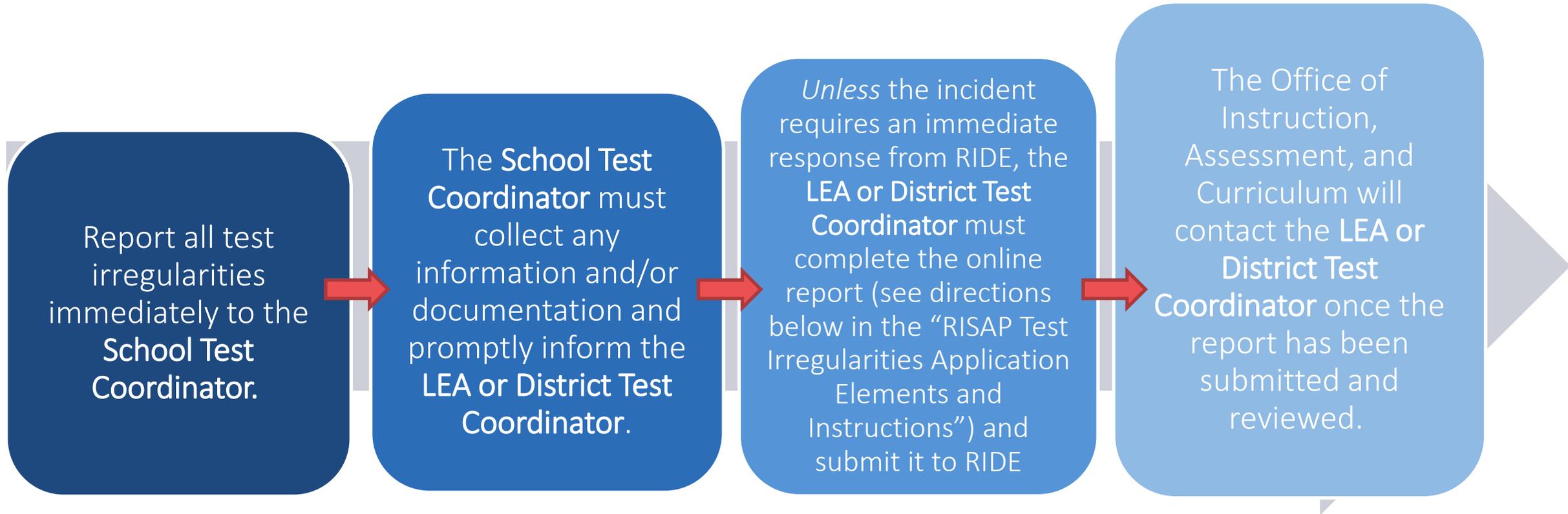

3. **LEA Test Coordinator** will instruct the school test coordinator to complete this form, as necessary. This form must be completed within five school days. The LEA Test Coordinator then faxes the form to RIDE at 401-222-3605. The completed form must never be sent via email as it contains personally identifiable student information which must be kept confidential.
4. Maintain a copy (electronic or physical) of the submitted form for your LEA/district and school files for three years.

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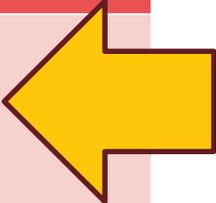
- We will be contacting superintendents, principals, and test coordinators via email to notify that visits will be occurring - Please respond to these emails.

# Best Practices for Selecting Your Testing Windows

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1. Determine how many staff you will need *before* selecting your testing window.
2. Use as much of the state testing window as possible. Even if your school testing window is over, if you're within the state assessment window, you can continue testing.
3. Plan to test 100% of students in each content area.
4. Start as early in the state primary testing window as possible.
5. Adhere to the state testing window for make-up testing.
