	C	<p>Students will understand the relationship of academics to the world of work and to life at home and in the community.</p> <p>Competency: Students will 1) relate school to life experience.</p>
CAREER	A	<p>Students will acquire the skills to investigate the world of work in relation to knowledge of self and to make informed career decisions.</p> <p>Competencies: Students will 1) develop career awareness and 2) develop employment readiness.</p>
	B	<p>Students will employ strategies to achieve future career goals with success and satisfaction.</p> <p>Competencies: Students will 1) acquire career information and 2) identify career goals.</p>
	C	<p>Students will understand the relationship between personal qualities, education, training, and the world of work.</p> <p>Competencies: Students will 1) acquire knowledge to achieve career goals and 2) apply skills to achieve career goals.</p>
