Program Explanation:	
Agency Background:	
<p>The William M. Davies, Jr. Career & Technical High School, located in Lincoln, RI, is a comprehensive career and technical high school serving approximately 875 students in grades 9–12. Davies' mission is to develop graduates who aspire to be productive, skilled workers, business leaders, and entrepreneurs. Davies provides both academic studies and career preparation programs of study. After a ninth grade exploratory experience, students choose career/technical preparation in, automotive technology, bio manufacturing, cosmetology, electrical, pre-engineering/robotics, graphic arts/printing, health careers, hospitality careers, and machine technology. The fully accredited academic program includes four years of math, English and science to prepare students for further education and/or employment.</p>	
<p>Davies works actively with a broad network of business partners to ensure that students graduate with the academic and technical preparation skills required for success in a rapidly changing job market. Actual work experience is an essential component of Davies comprehensive educational program. Davies students participate in work-based learning activities that include business tours, job shadows, unpaid internships, and “co-op” (paid internships) related to their technical areas of study. After graduation, many Davies students go on to higher education. Additionally, many students easily find employment related to their career/technical areas.</p>	
Agency Objective:	
<p>Davies' mission statement is to “Provide a challenging academic and technical education within a safe and supportive environment which ensures every industry-certified graduate is capable of pursuing higher education and becoming a productive participant in today’s workforce.”</p>	
<p>Davies prides itself on its ability to deliver credentialed quality career preparation programs that serve the emerging industries and the overall workforce needs within the State. Davies' focus remains on student achievement and accountability. Technical program curriculum is based on national standards and the technical areas provide the opportunity for certification in the students' chosen field upon graduation. In technical program performance, Davies students have demonstrated a mastery of skillsets as evidenced by successes at SkillsUSA State and National competitions.</p>	

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<p>In summary, Davies' main focus is to preserve the integrity of the instruction and learning processes in place at the school given the present climate of budgetary change, particularly in light of the new education funding formula and associated reductions that Davies will experience over the ten-year formula phase-in period.</p> <p><u>Proposed Budget Impacts:</u></p> <p>By legislation, Davies School is now funded via the education funding formula that became effective in fiscal 2012. More specifically, Davies is no longer a school fully funded by the State. Therefore, a portion of Davies' annual budget comes from State general revenues, and a portion referred to as "local share" comes from each of Davies' sending districts. <i>Davies is extremely impacted by the funding formula</i>, and the cumulative implications throughout the ten-year phase-in period are <i>dire</i>. In short, the education funding formula does not account for, nor align with, the instructional model such as Davies that consists of "two houses" of instruction – academic instruction and technical program preparation. Funding intended in part to offset the structural deficit created by the funding formula, such as CTE Categorical Funds, are available on a competitive application basis to <i>all</i> districts that provide technical programs. Therefore, there is no <i>additional predictable and consistent revenue stream</i> to offset the ramifications of the fiscal cliff created by the formula.</p> <p>Although the Governor convened a Funding Formula Working Group to study the formula, the process yielded no changes to the funding methodology encompassing career and technical education. A change was made, however, which allows Davies to request Stabilization Funds in an effort to have a mechanism to offset the structural deficit created by the core design of the funding formula. Stabilization funding is neither guaranteed nor predictable, and is based on General Assembly appropriation and approval. For its Fiscal 2018 budget request, Davies is in need of \$3.0m in stabilization funding just to maintain current services. Consideration must be given to proposed changes to the formula, such as a predictable CTE add-on factor to the annual core per-pupil amount, in recognition of the additional high cost involved to deliver career preparation programs. With four remaining years for the funding formula <i>reduction phase-in</i> (FY 2018 – FY 2021), Davies estimates its budgetary structural deficit will exceed \$6 million upon full transition of the funding formula in FY2021. The end result is that Davies is downsizing and/or eliminating some of its technical programs due to the fiscal constraints caused by the funding formula, beginning with Fiscal 2017 and beyond. Absent a change in the funding formula methodology to align to a model like Davies, current programs can no longer be sustained.</p>
