Brief explanation of professional learning experience:

Associate Level Orton-Gillingham Training:

This 70-hour online synchronous and asynchronous course will teach reading, spelling, and writing skills using the Orton-Gillingham approach, a structured alphabetic-phonetic system that engages visual, auditory, and kinesthetic pathways to develop the neural pathways for learning. All coursework and practicum follow the curriculum set forth by the Orton-Gillingham Academy.

Associate level training is ideal for all teachers, but especially those educators working with Tier 2 students (e.g., reading and ELL teachers), as well as Tier 3 instructors (i.e., special educators and speech pathologists). The Associate Level course <u>and</u> practicum prepares teachers to apply the principles of the O-G Approach in a 1:1 or small group setting.

Required with this course is a commitment to the 100-lesson practicum, including 10 observations by the supervising Fellow and/or Fellow-in-Training.

Course topics include:

- Typical literacy acquisition
- Neurological underpinnings of dyslexia
- Research-based, multisensory, systematic, and direct instruction for individuals with language-based learning difficulties
- Administration & interpretation of informal assessments
- Structure of the English language

- Phonological/Phonemic Awareness
- Phonics
- Spelling
- Vocabulary
- Comprehension
- Basic morphology
