Best Practices for Selecting Your Testing Windows

1. Determine how many staff you will need *before* selecting your testing window.
2. Use as much of the state testing window as possible. Even if your school testing window is over, if you're within the state assessment window, you can continue testing.
3. Plan to test 100% of students in each content area.
4. Start as early in the state primary testing window as possible.
5. Adhere to the state testing window for make-up testing.

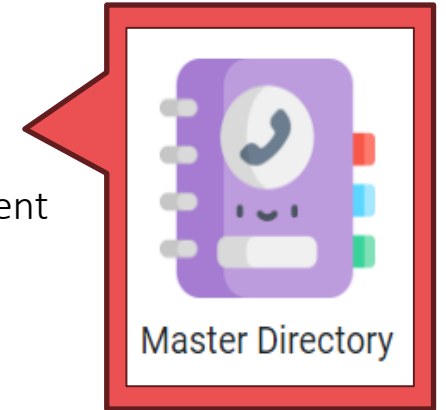

Update Master/School Directory

- There are now two ways to access RIDE's master/school directory:
 1. Through our **public** website: <https://datacenter.ride.ri.gov/Directory> (does not display emails)
 2. **Privately** through the [RIDE Portal](#). Click on the *Master Directory* icon under *Public Applications*.
- RIDE uses roles in the master directory to create accounts in each test platform and update the assessment listserv. RIDE also uses the physical addresses in the directory to ship test materials.
- Updating information in the directory has two steps:
 1. Email changes to anyone serving in the test coordinator role to assessment@ride.ri.gov.
 2. Inform your **data manager** of changes to the Master Directory. Data managers will make the changes in the Master Directory. Make sure your school and district addresses are correct and make sure the following roles are assigned, even if the person's title is different:
 - District Test Coordinator
 - School Test Coordinator
 - Principal
 - Data Manager
 - Technology Coordinator/Manager
 - SSD Coordinator (for schools administering SAT and PSAT 10)

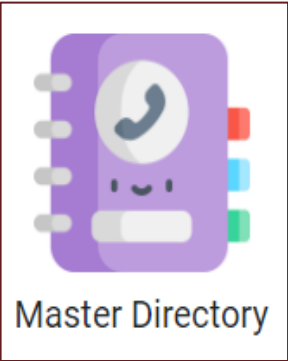

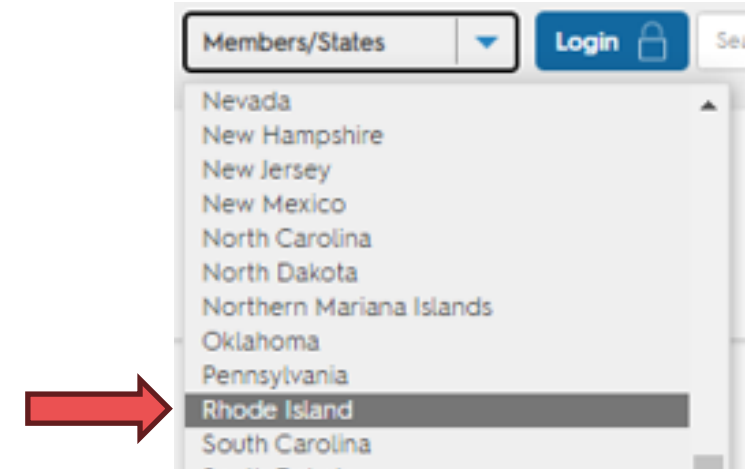

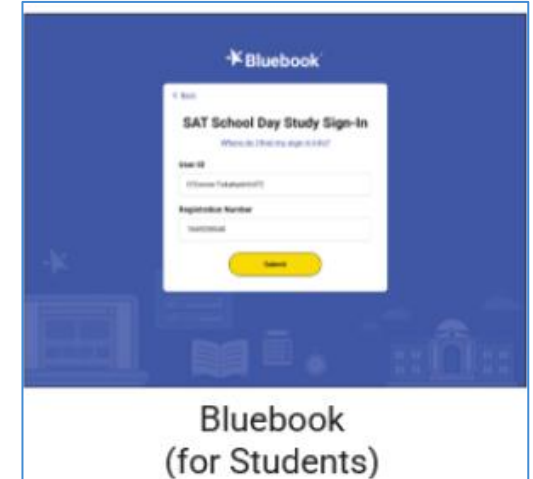

SAT/PSAT10 FAQs

- State Assessment SAT and PSAT 10 testing window:
 - April 1-11 PRIMARY TESTING April 21-28 MAKEUP TESTING
- Students take the assessment on the **BlueBook** app
 - **Reminder:** Students requiring a paper test will be taking the original linear paper test
- Multi-stage adaptive test
 - Students will take 2 modules in each content:
 - Module 1 will determine the "route" of module 2
 - Students are not aware of the transition from module 1 to module 2
 - Every student will have a unique test.

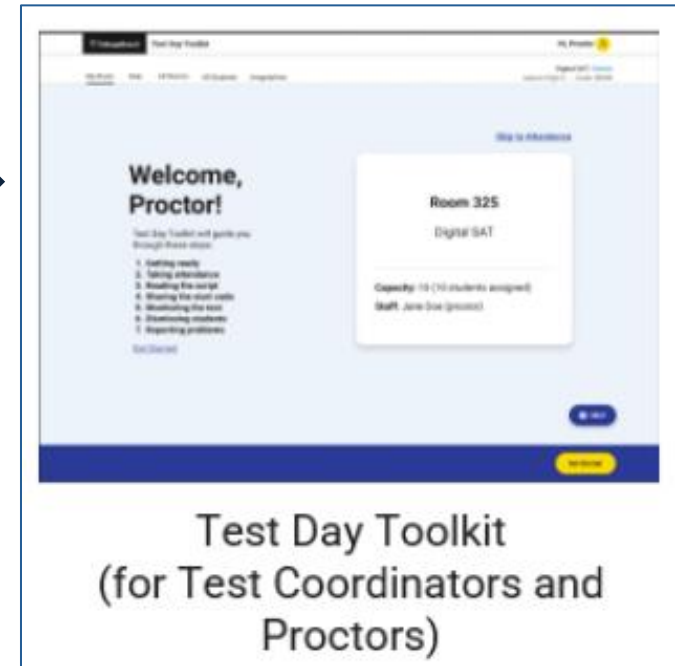

- Coordinators and Proctors will manage administration in Test Day Toolkit (TDTK)
 - SSD Online will talk to TDTK. Accommodations will automatically be linked.
- Testing time: **2 hrs. 44 minutes**
- Calculator is allowed on entire test and does not require an accommodation request.

Please note: Students may use their own calculator if it is on the approved list.

- Multi grade testing rooms *if necessary*

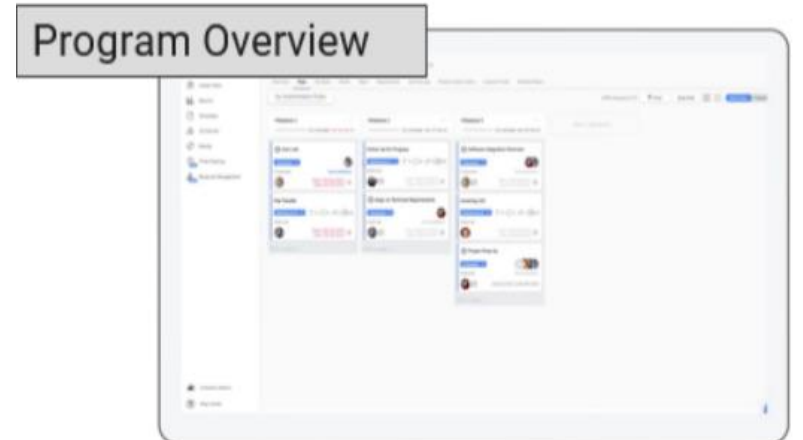
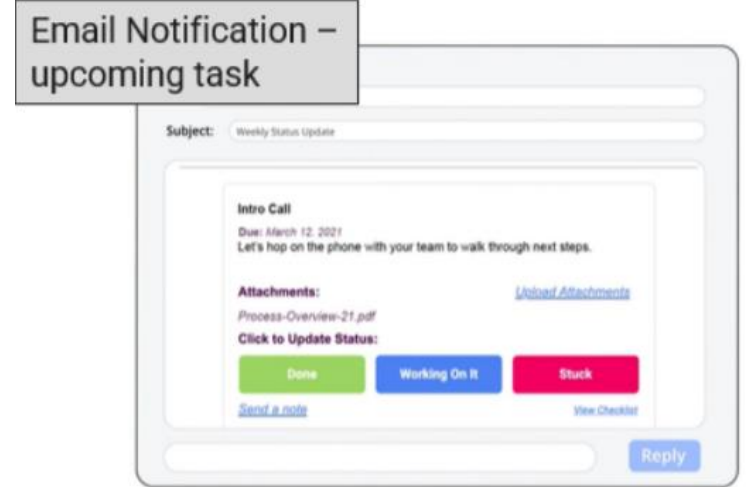

Onboarding Survey (will be sent Sept. 23): All test coordinators should complete the College Board onboarding survey no later than Oct 9th to ensure all information is accurate and received by College Board.

College Board Newsletters and Checklists: College Board will send out monthly newsletters and interactive checklists beginning in November. These checklists and newsletters will be posted to www.ride.ri.gov/tc.



RICAS FAQs

- The RICAS *assessment* will remain the same.
- Teachers and administrators will be using a *new platform* for test management for Spring 2025.
- Students will be using a *new application* for test administration for Spring 2025.
- Training opportunities to learn the new platform will be available this *winter*.

**Districts and schools will not be able to access data files housed in PearsonAccess^{next} after March 2025.*

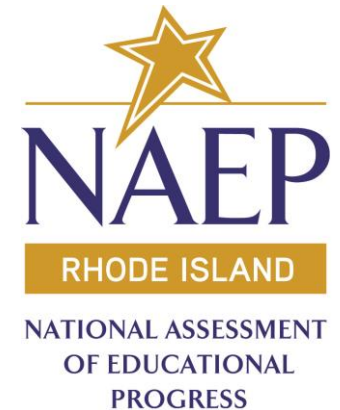

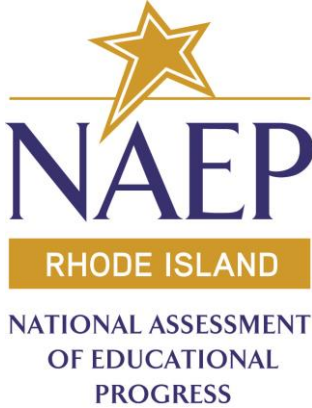

Sending Score Reports to Families

- Families should receive score reports no more than two months after LEAs receive them.*
- Score Report Shells in languages other than English are available for all state assessments.
- Outplacement Schools:
 - Sending LEAs are responsible for ensuring families receive score reports.
 - Sending LEAs are responsible for providing outplacement schools with score reports for student records.

Score Interpretation Materials

- Available for teachers and families
- Available for past years' assessments

***NOTE:** The NGSA science and RICAS ISRs are the exception to this rule because they include state-level data that has not yet been released to the public. LEAs must wait to send the NGSA and RICAS ISRs to families until all state assessment data has been released.

2023-24 Alternate ACCESS Score Reports

Important changes to the WIDA Alternate ACCESS Score Reports:

- The Individual Student Report (ISR) has been redesigned.
- There are now two Individual Student Reports (ISR): One for educators and one for families. The ISR for educators includes the Individual Characteristics Questionnaire information that can help educator teams make program decisions for students.
- Alternate ACCESS proficiency level scores now range from Proficiency Level (PL) 1-5 and are unique from other ACCESS tests

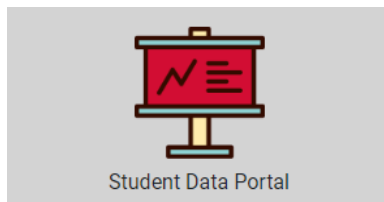

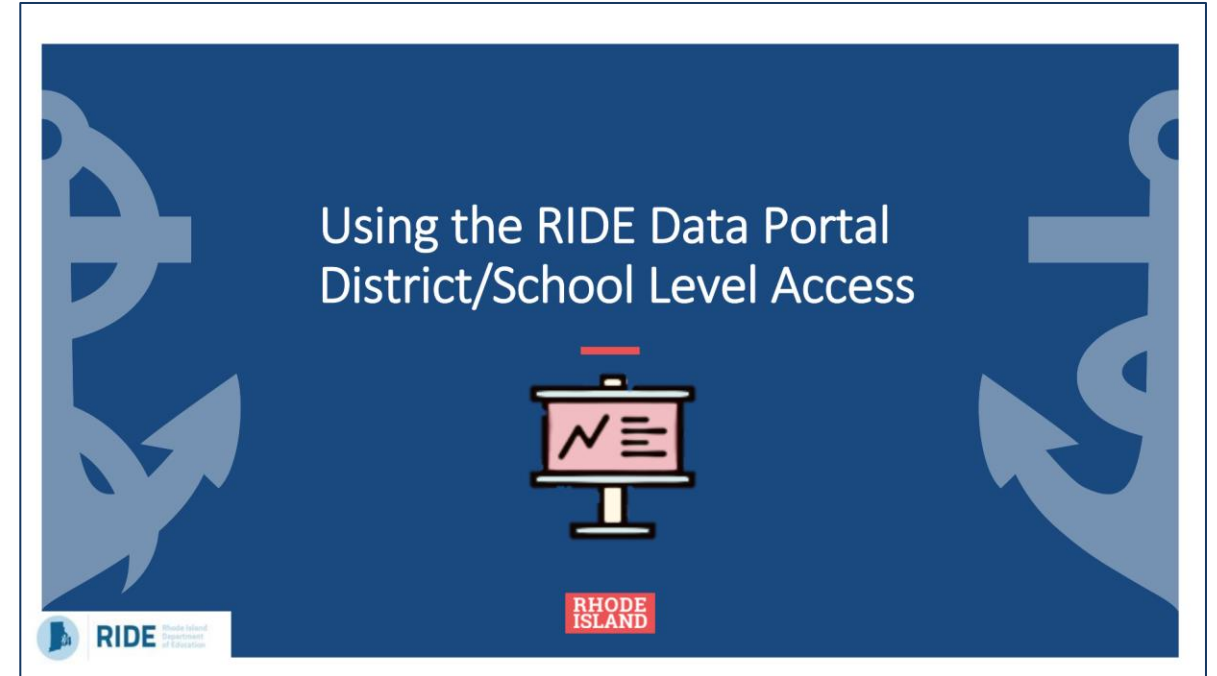
