Test Coordinator and Test Administrator Training Requirements

All state assessments require district and school test coordinators to receive training on how to prepare for and administer each state assessment being given in their district and school. Each assessment in the RI State Assessment Program (RISAP) has its own training options for test coordinators. Most state assessments will have an online or self-paced training module and an in-person training opportunity from which test coordinators can choose.

District and school test coordinators are also responsible for training test administrators to give the tests properly. Training requirements for test administrators are included in the back of this document.

All Tests

Monthly Test Coordinator Webinars. These meetings are a staple in keeping everyone involved with preparing for state assessments up to date. These meetings are not only for test coordinators. We welcome anyone at the district or school level involved in preparing for or administering the state assessments. ACCESS for ELLs / WIDA Alternate ACCESS

Training requirements below are given for test coordinators and test administrators. All training dates, registration links, access links to online modules, and presentation recording links can be found on the preceding pages.

Before you begin:

- Get a WIDA Secure Portal account. Test Coordinators and test administrators must have a WIDA Secure Portal account before any training can take place. ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS training courses. Anyone administering the ACCESS for ELLs or WIDA Alternate ACCESS must complete the training course and successfully pass the online quiz every three years. Any test administrator who will be scoring the Speaking domain must recertify annually. Test Coordinators and test administrators must have their own Lighthouse Portal account. All training for RICAS will be provided by RIDE; however, all test administrators MUST have an account to administer the assessment.

- Get an eMetric Lighthouse Portal account. Test coordinators and test administrators must have a Lighthouse Portal account to complete accommodations set-up for students, create rosters, and complete other important tasks before testing can begin. Follow these instructions to obtain an account:
 - □ **Test administrators** who need a Lighthouse Portal account must contact their school test coordinator to request an account.
 - □ School test coordinators who need accounts should contact their district test coordinator or district data manager for access.
