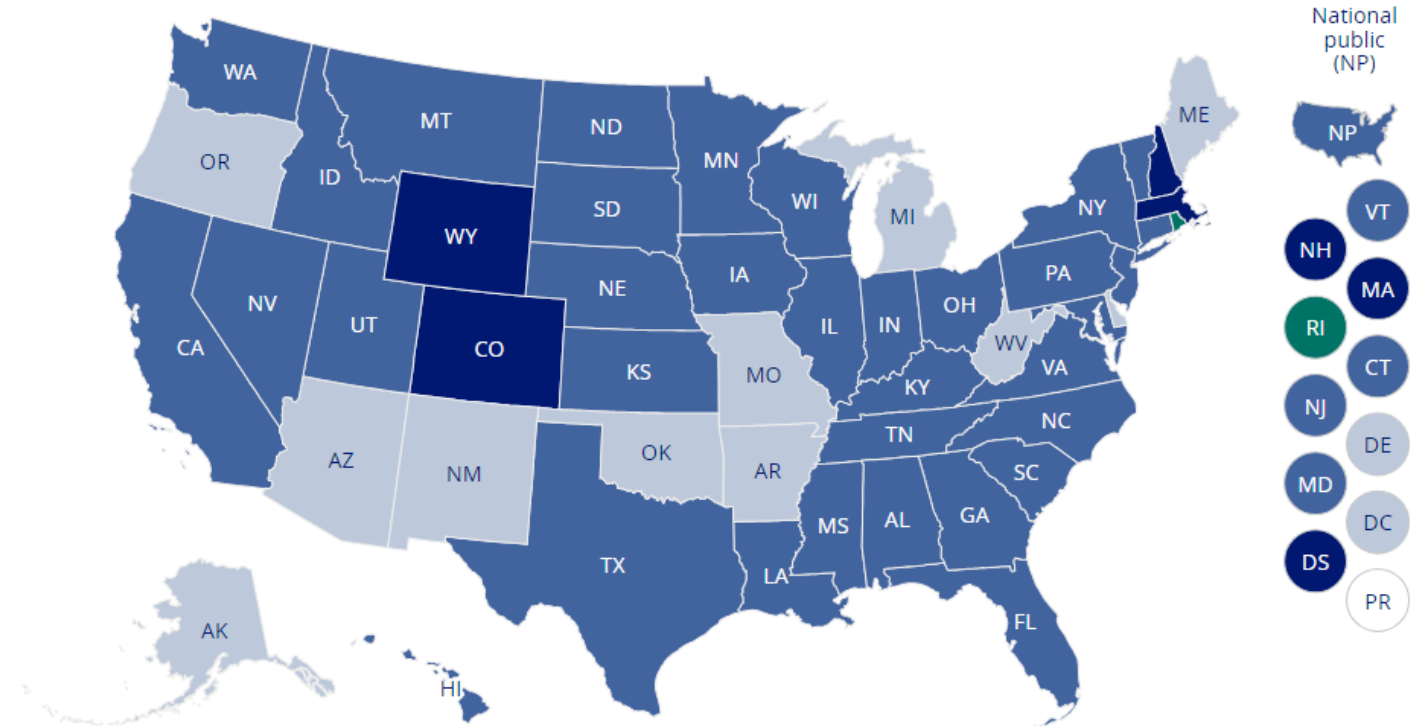

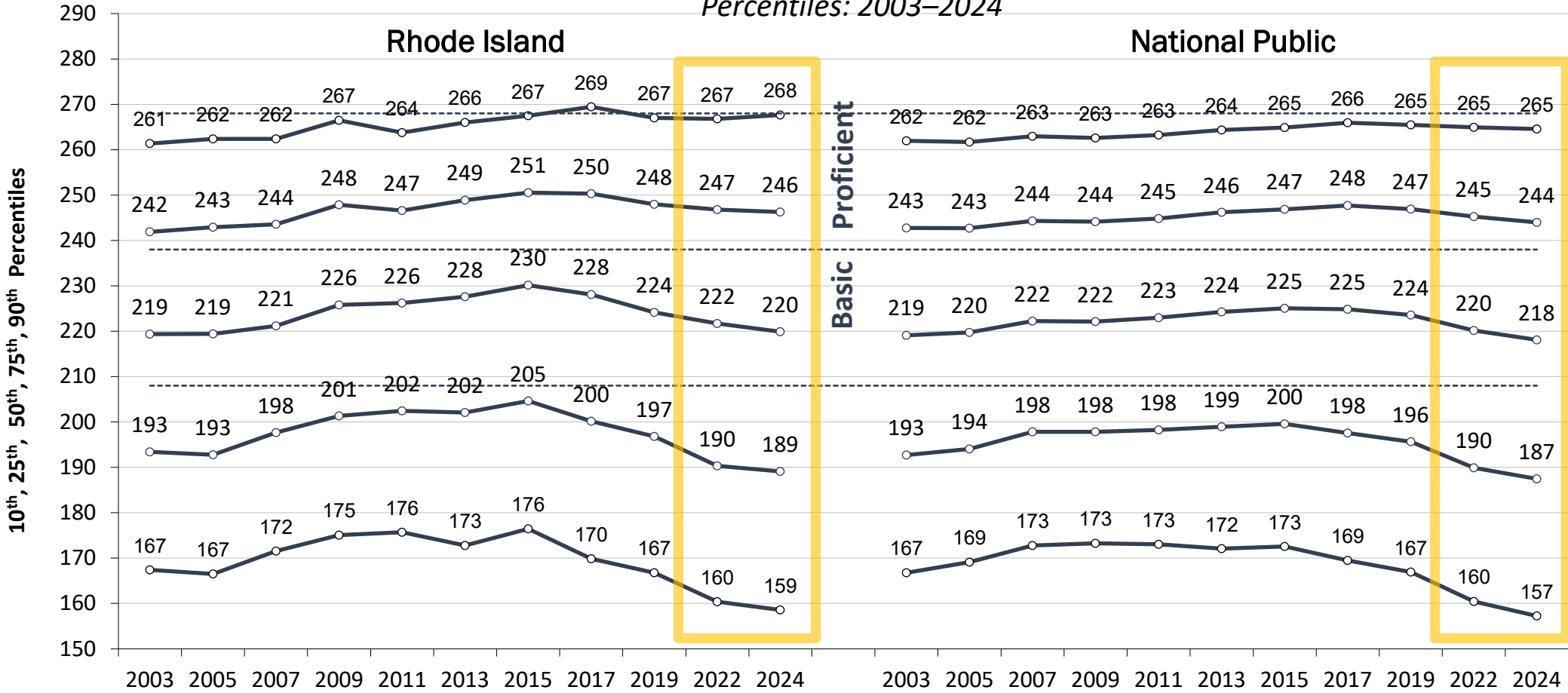

Vermont	-9.1*	213	217	222
Maine	-11.6*	210**	213**	221

>>In 2024 RI had the lowest significant decrease of NE states from 2019<<

- Louisiana is the only state that significantly increased from 2019 (+6)
- All NE states except NH (-2.8) had **significant decreases** in scale scores between 2024/2019
 - MA & NH scale scores are statistically higher than RI in 2024
 - Maine scale scores are statistically lower than RI in 2024
- CT & VT average scale scores were not significantly different from RI in 2024

AVERAGE SCALE SCORES

2024 Rhode Island average scale score (0-500)

RI 258

9 jurisdictions performed significantly higher

30 jurisdictions not significantly different

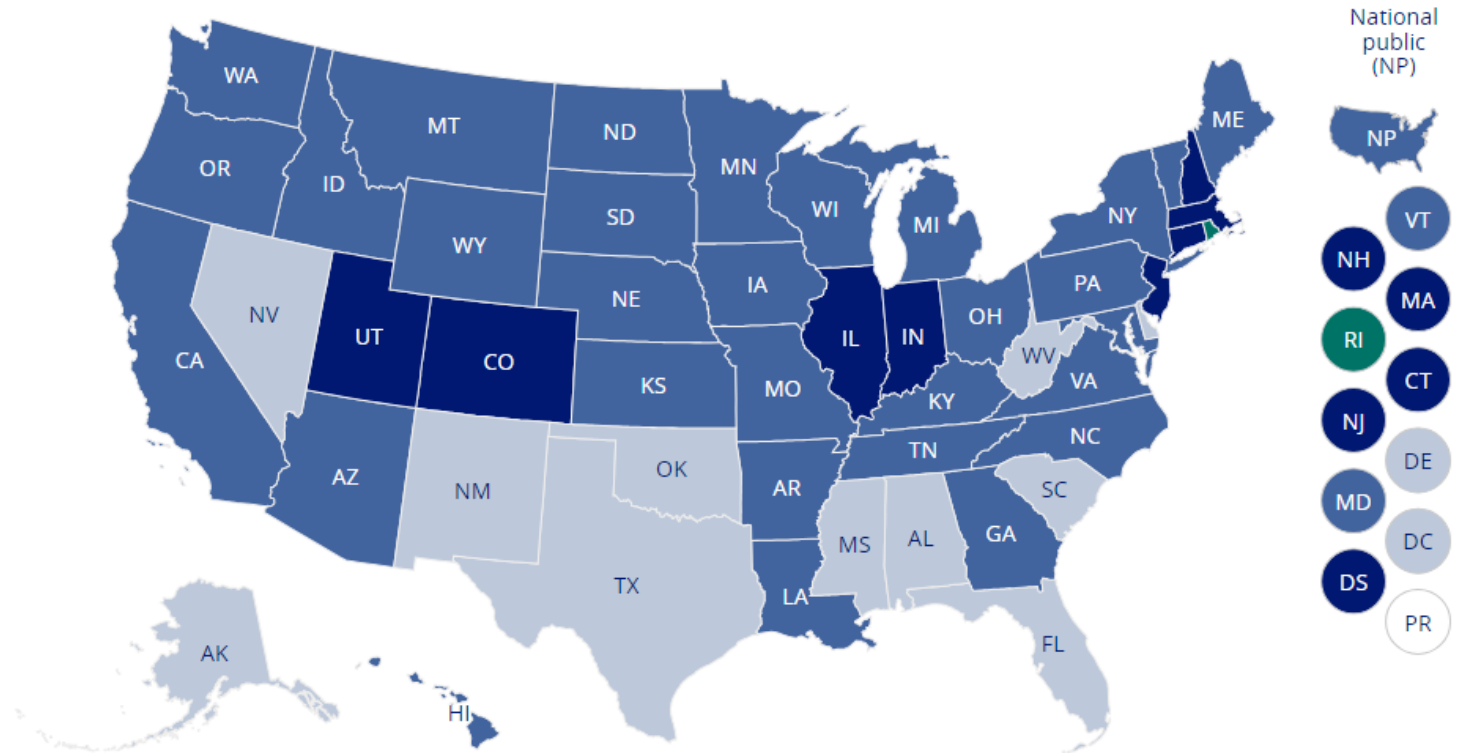

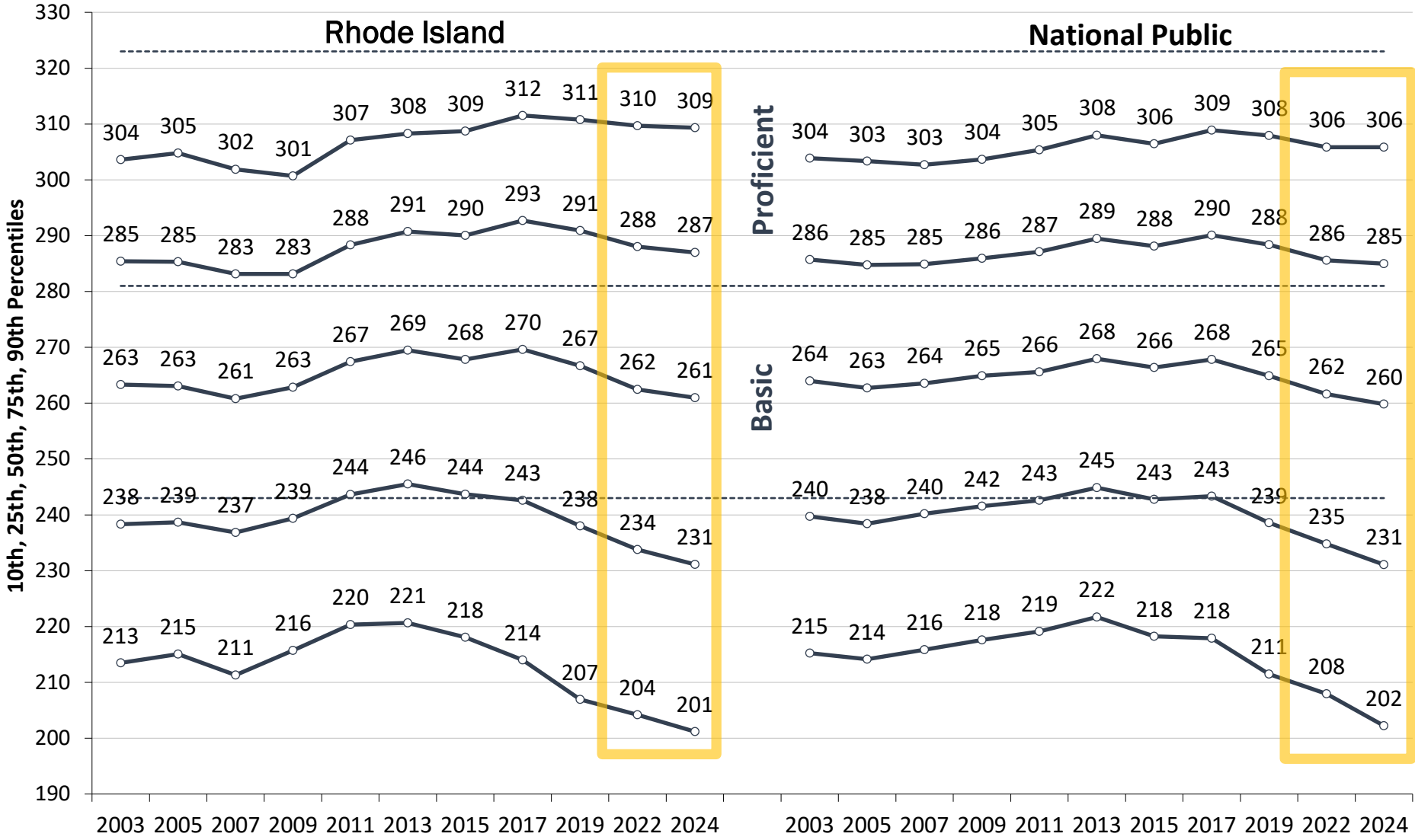

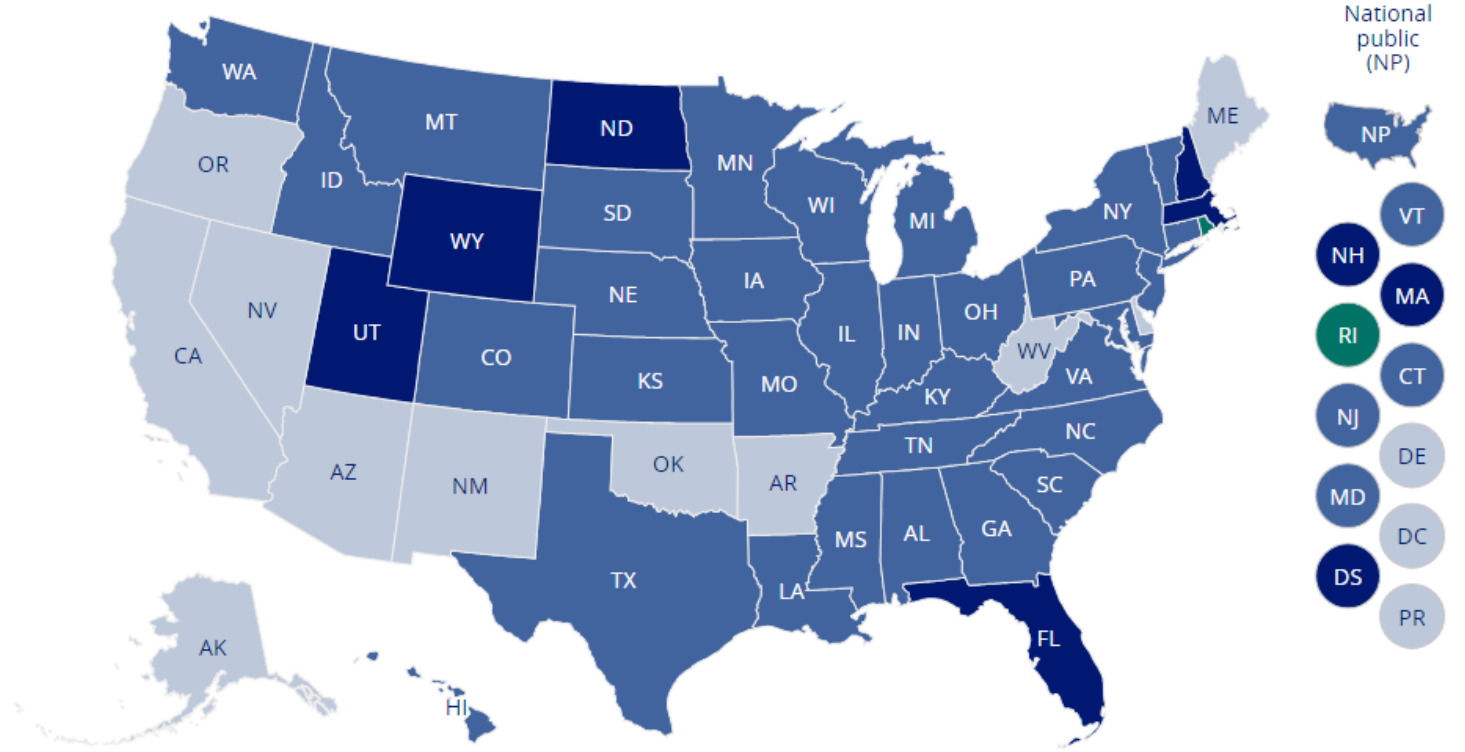
- No states in the nation improved significantly from 2019 or 2022 in composite reading
- All New England states decreased significantly from 2019 in composite scale score
- MA, NH, and CT scale scores are higher than RI**
- Vermont & Maine scale scores were lower than RI**

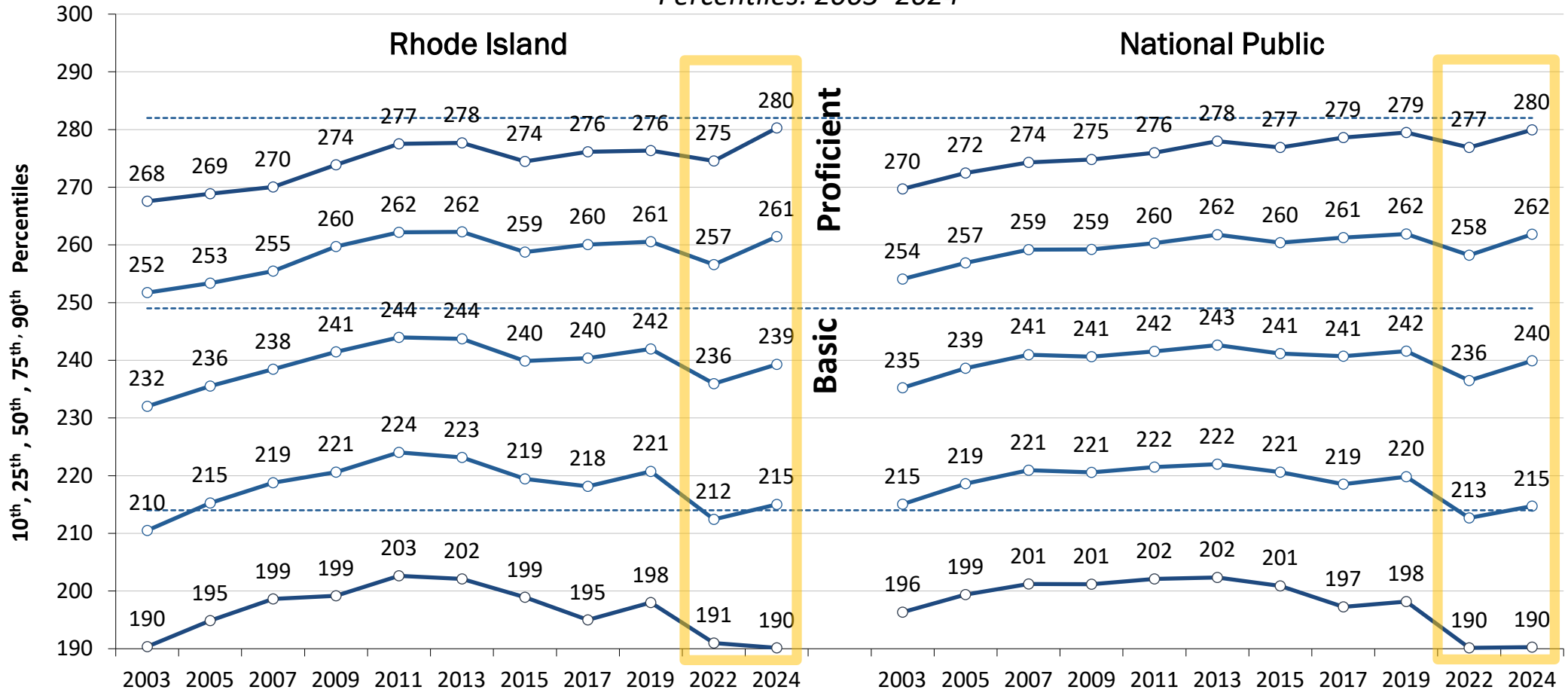

- 14 states significantly increased since 2022, and 1 decreased (Nebraska)
- 1 state significantly increased since 2019 (AL), and 20 states significantly decreased
- RI and MA increased significantly since 2022, no significant change in CT, NH, VT, ME
- RI and MA increased significantly since 2019, NH, VT, CT, ME decreased significantly

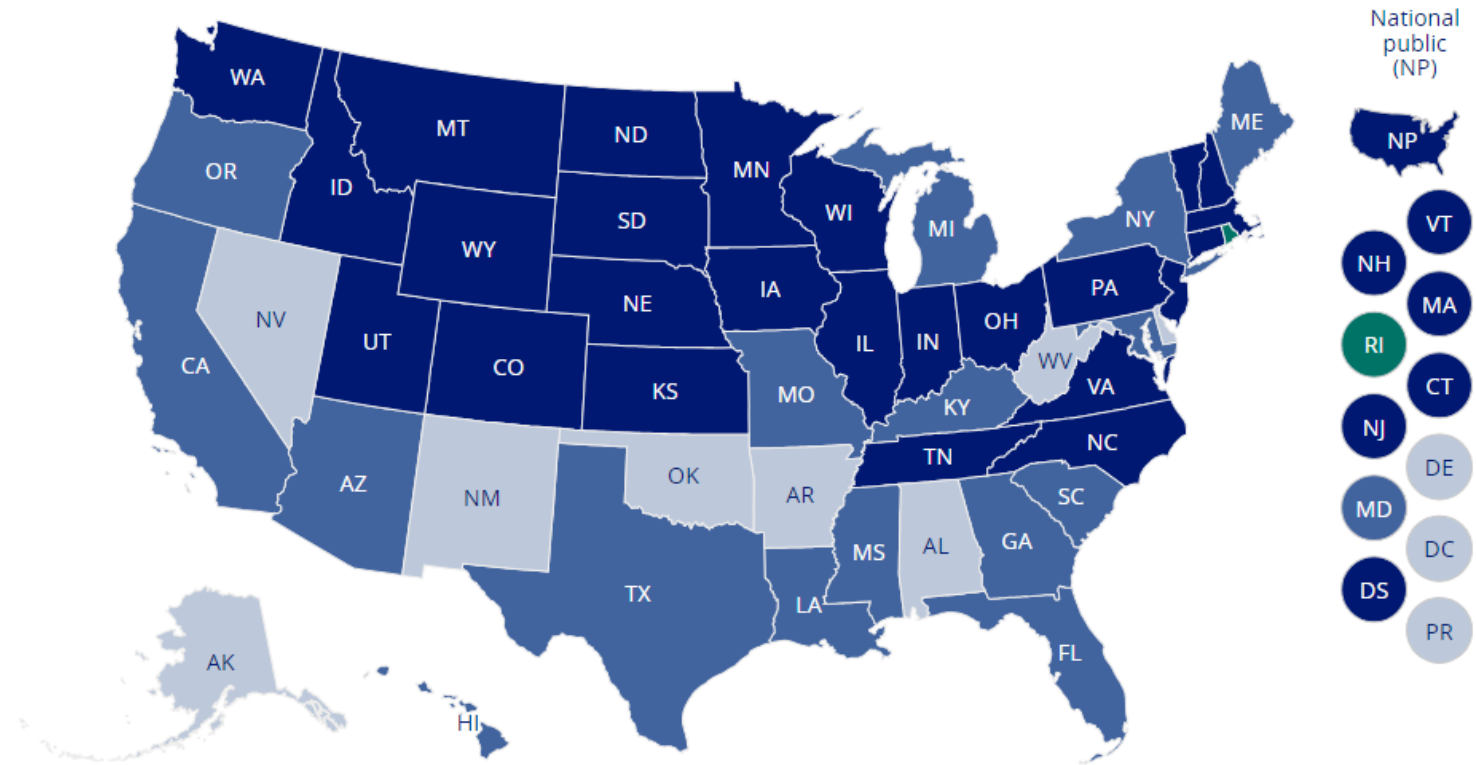

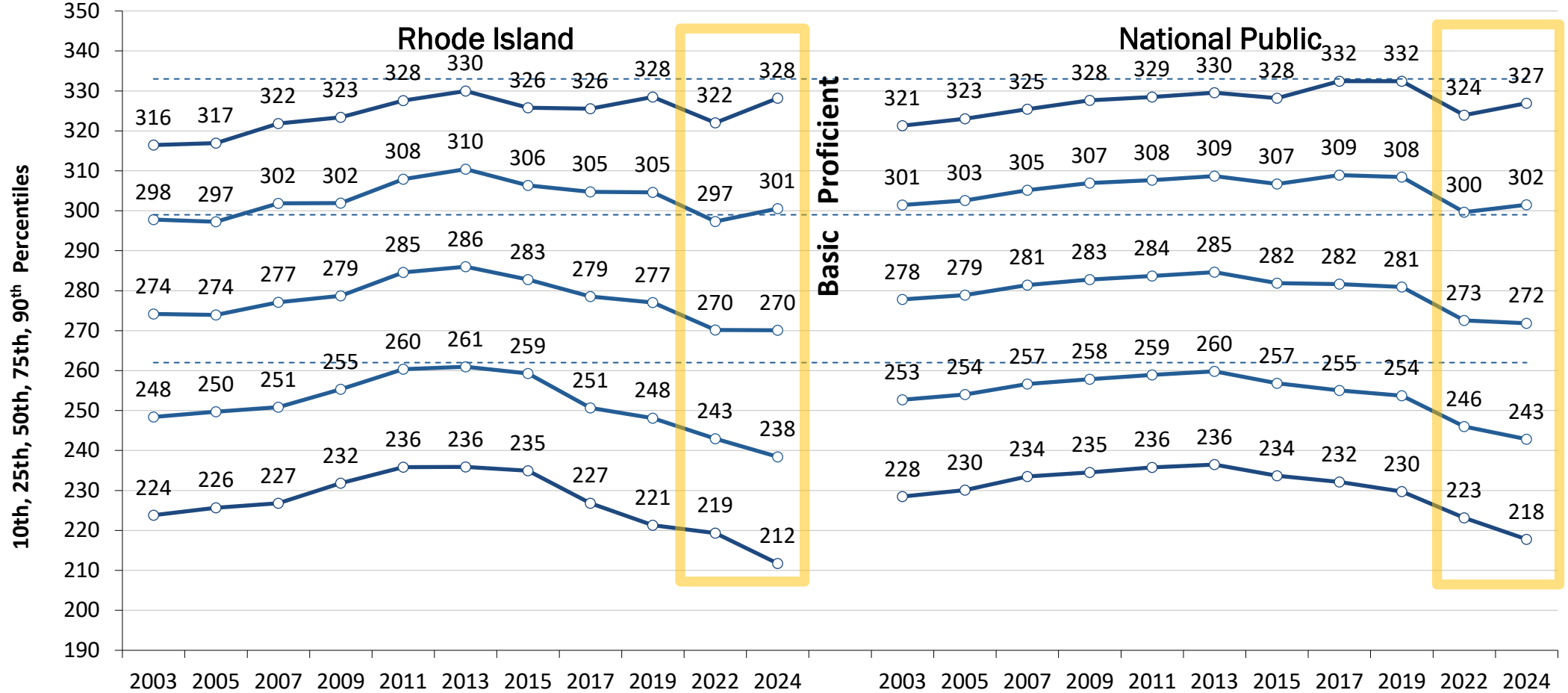

- Rhode Island had the smallest decline of scale scores of the NE States 2024 v 2019
- No New England state was statistically different 2024 v 2022
