RI Pre-K is currently accepting applications from families with children who turn four on or before September 1, 2025, are not eligible for kindergarten, and live in one of the eligible communities listed below.

Application Information

The lottery is available online and through this paper application.

All lottery applications must be entered into the online lottery system to be eligible for lottery selection. To have your paper application entered into the online lottery system please bring your application to a participating RI Pre-K program.

An active email address needs to be included in the RI Pre-K lottery. This email address is where you will receive an application confirmation code and notification from a program of your child's lottery selection.

Once the application information is uploaded into the online system, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address listed on the application. If you do not receive a confirmation email, please follow up with the program.

Paper applications must be delivered to the program by 4:00 pm, on June 20, 2025.

Online applications will be accepted until 11:59 pm on Sunday, June 22, 2025.

To be eligible for RI Pre-K enrollment, children must:

- Turn or be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2025; and
- Not be eligible to attend Kindergarten; and
- Live in the community in which the Pre-K program is located; and
- Agree to all eligibility and enrollment requirements.

A copy of a birth certificate, proof of residency, and proof of **monthly** family total income will be required upon enrollment. The family's total income will be verified to match what is reported in this application for child enrollment to be completed.

Total *monthly* family income is defined as gross cash income (<u>income before taxes or</u> <u>deductions</u>) and includes all income, military income (including pay and allowances), veterans' benefits, Social Security benefits, unemployment compensation, and public assistance benefits.

Verification of all these elements may impact eligibility for the program, even if selected through the state supervised lottery. As a result, please ensure all information is accurate before applying.

Each classroom enrolls 18 to 20 children. Children will be assigned to classrooms in their community of residence either randomly through the lottery, or in order, based on a waitlist.

When completing an application for communities that have more than one RI Pre-K program, families may prioritize their top 3 choices. If selected, you will have the option of accepting that seat or being added to the waitlist for another program within that community.

Please *do not* submit applications to the RI Department of Education.

Only **one application per child** (same age siblings must be entered on one application) will be accepted. Duplicate applications will be deleted. Application information and program selections will be entered into the online lottery system.

Once the application information is uploaded into the online system, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address listed on the application.

If you do not receive a confirmation email, please follow up with the program.
