


# PSAT Individual Student Report Guide

A paper copy of the ISR, or access to a digital PDF, may be provided to families from the student's school district. Families and students may also access ISRs through their College Board account.


ISRs include the following information, explained in more detail in this guide:

- student scale score and achievement level for ELA and mathematics
- student total score for each content area
- section scores for each content area
- student performance across the content domains
- percentile rank score for total test and each content area
