



SAT Individual Student Report Guide

Each student's family receives their child's SAT results in the form of an individual student report (ISR). A paper copy of the ISR, or access to a digital PDF, may be provided to families from the student's school district. Families and students may also access ISRs through their College Board account.

ISRs include the following information, explained in more detail in this guide:

- student scale score and achievement level for ELA and mathematics
- student total score for each content area
- section scores for each content area
- student performance across the content domains
- percentile rank score for total test and each content area




Student's achievement level in math and ELA

The colored bars below show the score range for each achievement level.


The Knowledge and Skills section of the report shows your child's performance on each of the eight content domains measured. For each area you can see:

SAT English Language Arts Achievement Levels




SAT Mathematics Achievement Levels
