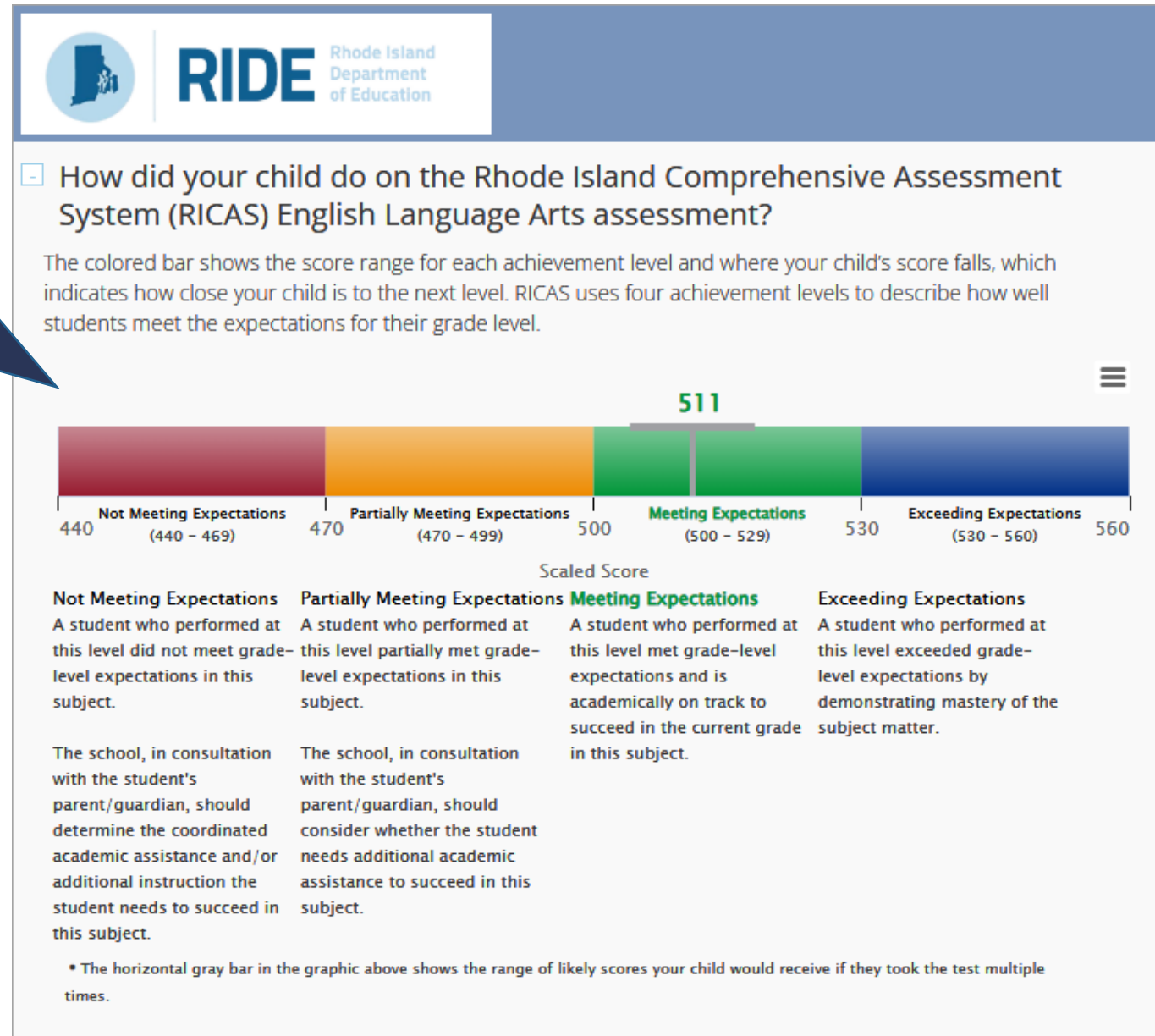

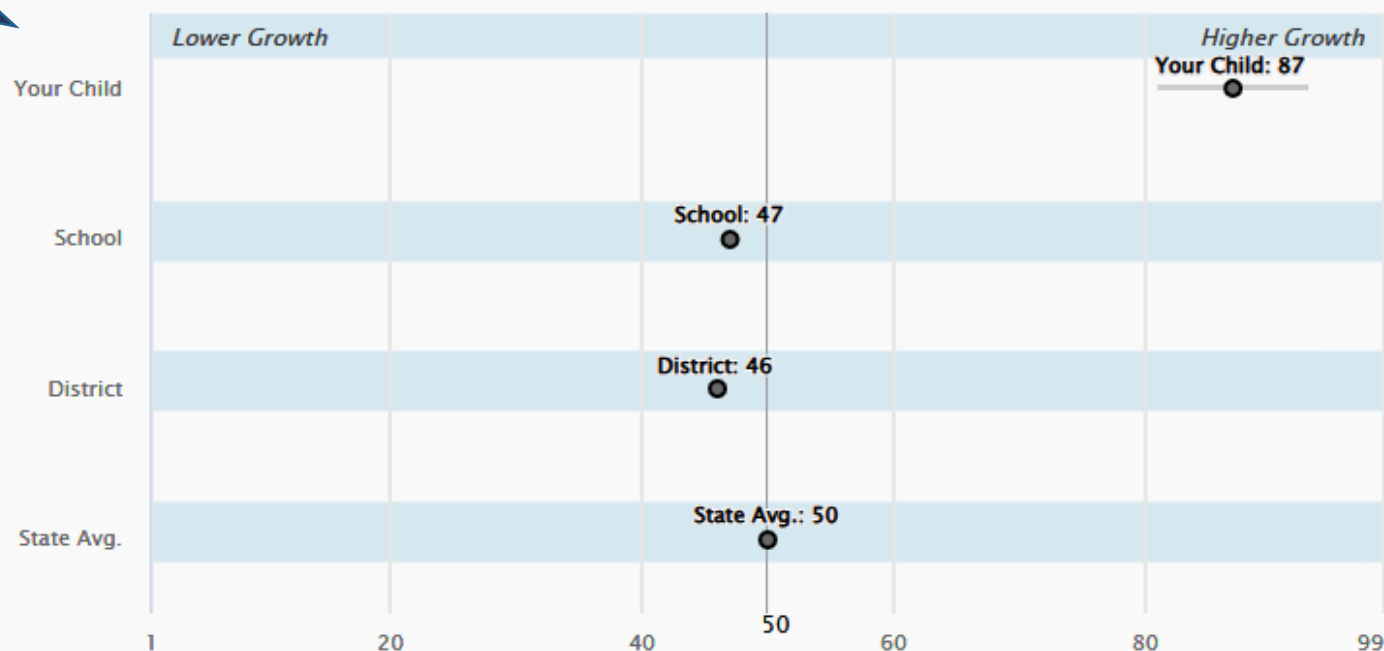

Student Growth Percentiles



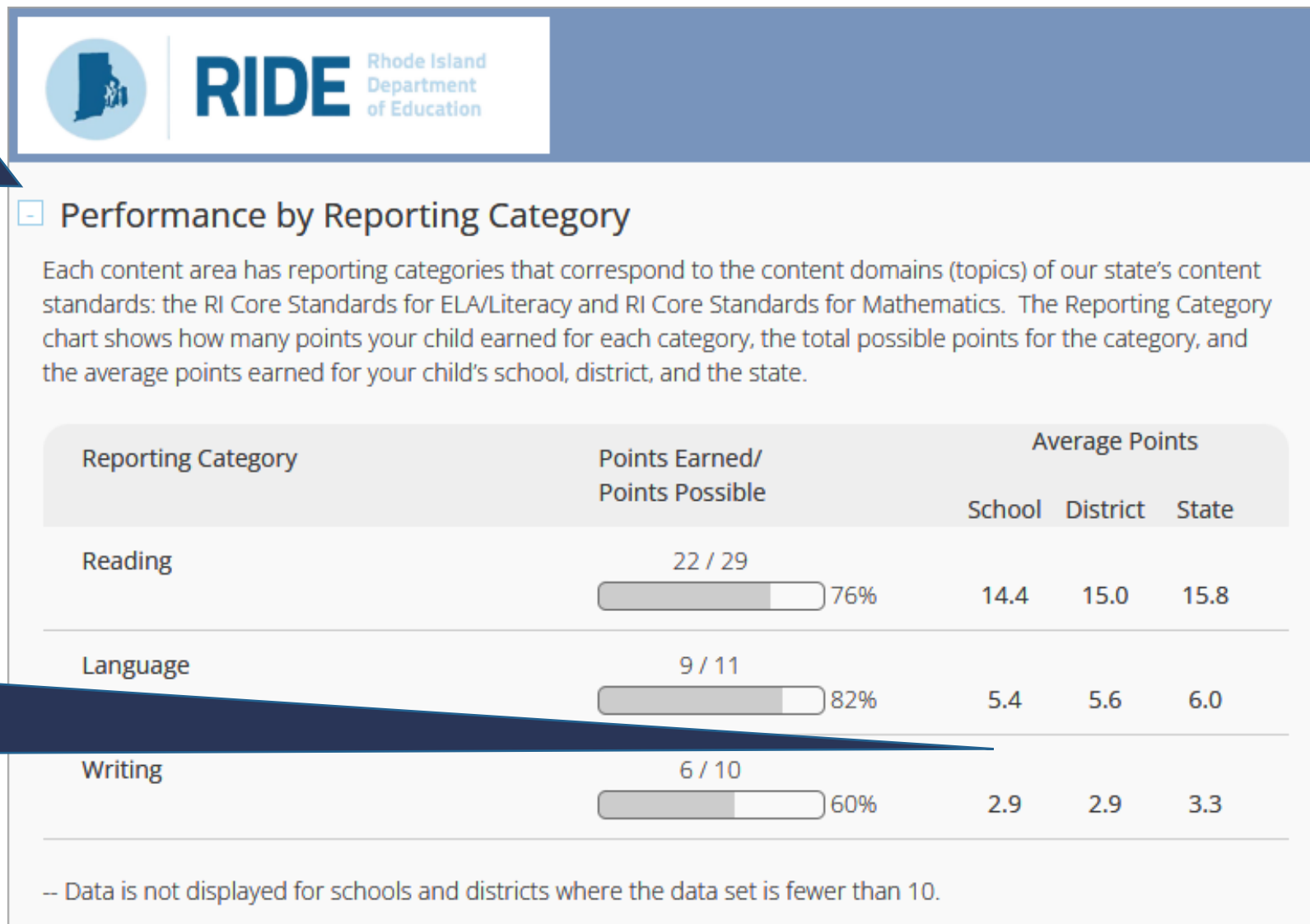
