

RICAS Updates

RICAS Portal

- ✓ New users will receive a single email that contains both their username and password, instead of two separate emails.
- ✓ Session Access Code will now be "Access Code".
- ✓ Test Coordinators will be able to bulk print student logins for ALL tests in one download
- ✓ A new "Progress View" on the View Details page will allow test administrators to see how many items each student has visited and answered, overall status, last activity recorded.

RICAS Student KIOSK

- ✓ A message will **pop up** on the screen **warning students** that the **test will timeout** due to inactivity with a 1-minute timer.
- ✓ Answer Eliminator will no longer be available for students but may continue to access the answer masking feature which provides the same level of support.
- ✓ The names of the colors for color contrast have been updated to be more descriptive rather than being named (i.e., orange on brown).
- ✓ The ruler has been updated to a blue color scheme.
- ✓ The TI calculator has been updated to the latest version and all calculators (TI, eMetric and Desmos) will show degrees by default.
- ✓ Student's name will appear in the top right corner of the directions page.

Accommodations



Who is a Multilingual Learner?

This means the student meets one of these conditions:

- 1. The student is currently receiving instruction to learn English,
- 2. the student has exited the MLL program and is in the monitoring process, or
- 3. the student has been identified as MLL but is not in a program to learn English.

Text-To-Speech/Human Read Aloud for RICAS Math and NGSA

NEW for 2025: TTS and Human Read Alouds are now a special PLP accommodation for RICAS Math and NGSA Science.

- This does mean that students identified as MLL or students who have a PLP (Personal Literacy Plan) receiving a tier 2 or tier 3 reading intervention, may benefit from text-to-speech (TTS) for the math tests in English and, for NGSA science, English and Spanish.
- This does not mean that all students should receive this test support "just in case". This is for students
 who have PLPs.

Best Practices for Selecting Your Testing Windows

- 1. Determine how many staff you will need *before* selecting your testing window.
- 2. Use as much of the state testing window as possible. Even if your school testing window is over, if you're within the state assessment window, you can continue testing.
- Plan to test 100% of students in each content area.
- 4. Start as early in the state primary testing window as possible.
- 5. Adhere to the state testing window for make-up testing.
