Proctor Preview in Test Day Toolkit (TDTK)

School Test Coordinators will gain access to the Test Day Toolkit during the first week of February. The Test Day Toolkit supports key test-day tasks, including rostering students, setting up testing rooms, printing sign-in tickets, and administering the assessment. New for the Spring 2026 administration, Proctor Preview allows test day staff to log in ahead of test day to explore the system and walk through the full testing flow without accessing live student data. We strongly encourage coordinators and test day staff to log into the Test Day Toolkit early and take advantage of Proctor Preview to build familiarity and confidence before test day.
