The Fiscal Year 2023 State Budget included a \$50M allocation to the School Building Authority (SBA) Capital Fund, designed to provide upfront funding for projects. The SBA Capital Fund, consistent with statute and the Basic Education Plan, is used to support public school improvements to ensure that funding has the greatest impact on achievement gaps in the State's priority areas, providing high-quality educational opportunities for all public students. The *Menu for Success* will support career and technical education by capitalizing on Rhode Island's well-established food tourism economy to foster educational opportunities for our students in areas such as accounting, automotive, culinary, entrepreneurship and graphic design.

Consistent with R.I.G.L. §16-105-1(a) and §16-105-3(1) the *Menu for Success* will provide select LEAs with funding for mobile classrooms, learning spaces, equipment and amenities needed to enhance their career and technical education.

**RECOMMENDATION:** THAT, the Council approves the allocation of \$1,625,000 of the Fiscal Year 2023 SBA Capital Fund as follows:
