Expert Residency Preliminary Certificate Overview

Effective January 1, 2015 individuals may apply for the Expert Residency Preliminary Certificate.¹ This certificate may be awarded to prospective educators who demonstrate sufficient preparation in subject matter, administrative expertise, or other certificate area-specific requirements to be considered for positions as educators while pursuing a path to Full Certification. A bachelor’s degree is required for all certification areas and an advanced degree is required for some certification areas.

Conditions for Issuance:

Duration and Renewal:

- The Expert Residency Preliminary Certificate is valid for one year and may be renewed up to three times.
