

“Let’s Get Ready” Community of Practice RIDE Coaching Sessions Available to LEAs

The “Let’s Get Ready” Community of Practice was created to support Rhode Island High Schools with the implementation of Readiness-Based Graduation Requirements. As part of the Community of Practice, RIDE is offering optional coaching to any LEA that has questions or needs support related to the implementation of Readiness-Based Graduation Requirements.

What are the coaching sessions?

1-hour long, virtual or in-person, based upon the needs your school team identifies when you sign up. Schools can request coaching sessions for general support related to RIDE’s Readiness-Based Graduation Requirements, and also for support related to specific implementation questions/challenges as they arise.

When are the coaching sessions?

As scheduled, between September 2023 and June 2024.

Who will be in the coaching sessions?

At least one member of the RIDE coaching team as well as an external facilitator will be available to support your school team during each coaching session.

Who from our school team should participate in the coaching session(s)? This depends based upon your school’s reason for requesting a coaching session. There is no minimum or maximum number of participants, it could be as few as one person, or as many as needed, depending on the topic that is being discussed. We recommend attending as a school team that includes relevant stakeholders based upon your reason for requesting a coaching session. Examples of school team members include (but are not limited to):

- Superintendent
- Assistant Superintendent
- Principal
- Assistant Principal
- Curriculum Director
- Department Chair
- Teacher
- Special Education Director
- School Counselor
- MLL Coordinator
