



Title IV-A Public Reporting of Federal Fiscal Year 19 Funds

Section 4104(a)(2) of the Every Student Succeeds Act requires that each State educational agency shall publicly report on how funds made available under Title IV, Part A are being expended by local educational agencies (LEAs) across the three Title IV-A content areas: Well-Rounded Education Opportunities, Safe and Health Students and Effective Use of Technology, pursuant to Section 4106(e)(2)(F). The data below reflects the information that the Rhode Island Department of Education has collected from local educational agencies (LEAs) through the annual Title IV-A End of the Year Expenditure Reports and the Annual Allocations by Payment and Source Reports. This information is for the Federal Fiscal Year 19 grant award, which began on July 1, 2019.
