



## **Title IV-A Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grants Progress toward Meeting School Year 2019-2020 Goals**

Section 4104(a)(2) of the Every Student Succeeds Act requires that each State educational agency shall publicly report on the degree to which local educational agencies (LEAs) have made progress toward meeting the objectives and outcomes described in the agencies' applications across the three Title IV-A content areas: Well-Rounded Education Opportunities, Safe and Health Students and Effective Use of Technology, pursuant to Section 4106(e)(1)(E). The data below reflects the information that the Rhode Island Department of Education has collected from local educational agencies (LEAs) through the annual Title IV-A Funding Application, which captures annual updates on LEAs progress in meeting program outcomes using the following measures: Met; On Track / Making Progress towards Multi-year Goal; or Delayed / Unable to meet.
