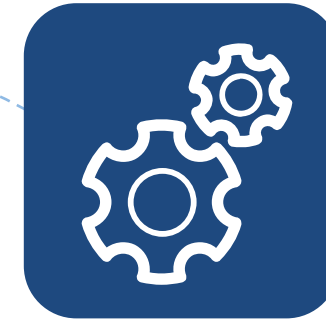
ESSA State Plan

LEA Strategic Plans

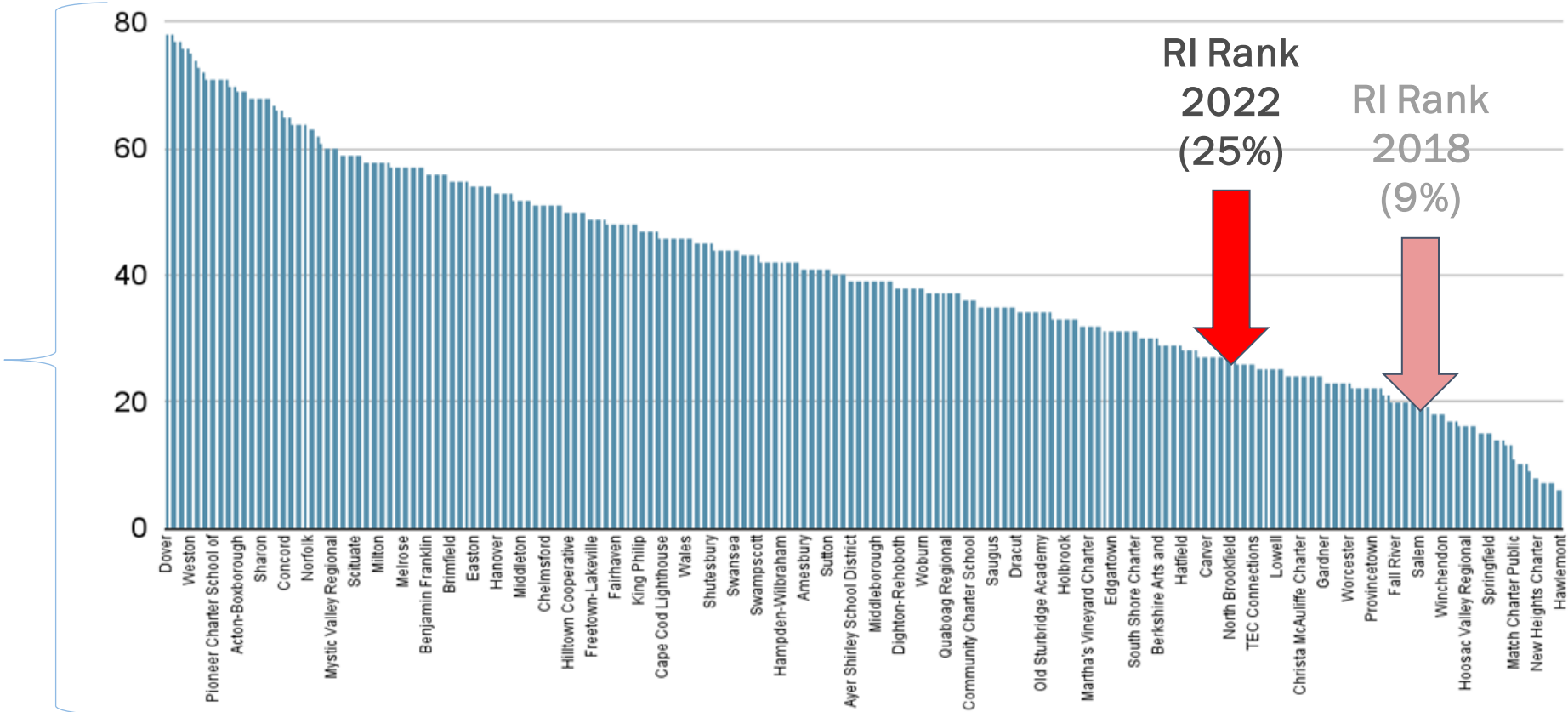
LEAs are currently in the process of establishing strategic plans with annual improvement targets

Rhode Island has made significant progress on how it would comparably rate if it were treated as an LEA in Massachusetts, now ranking above the 20th percentile in both ELA and Math based on 2022 RICAS results.

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Establishing Learn365RI Performance Goals



- 1) RI and LEAs will all have 2030 and annual performance goals
 - Learn365RI metrics (RICAS ELA/Math, Student Chronic Absenteeism, FAFSA)
- 2) All goals are preliminary
 - Still much we need to learn about the impact of COVID-19)
- 3) LEAs encouraged to include Learn365RI performance areas in their LEA strategic plans
- 4) Learn365RI performance goals are the “floor” → ESSA strategic plan is the “North Star”
 - Most LEAs already established goals in their strategic plan more rigorous than Learn365RI goals

RIDE has set preliminary statewide 2030 performance goals for each of these metrics to enable Rhode Island to both meet and beat MA's performance levels, and to position RI as a national leader.

Setting 2030 RICAS Goals – Methodology

After evaluating multiple potential models against the guiding principles, RIDE used the following key assumptions in its final recommended methodology for state and LEA 2030 goals for RICAS ELA & Math:

Preliminary Initial Goals

We still need to learn more about student performance, and will update goals/projections with the 2023 assessment release later this fall.

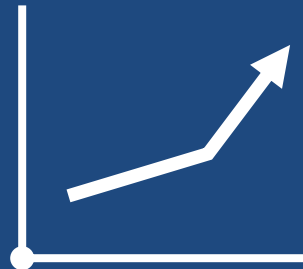


Vs. Massachusetts's Improvement

Based on historic data, assume MA will have a 1% avg. annual improvement in ELA/Math (update based on 2023 results)

Ramp-Up Approach

Over next 8 testing cycles, anticipate that 40% of the RI-MA RICAS gap will be closed during first 4 years and 60% of the gap will be closed during the following 4 years

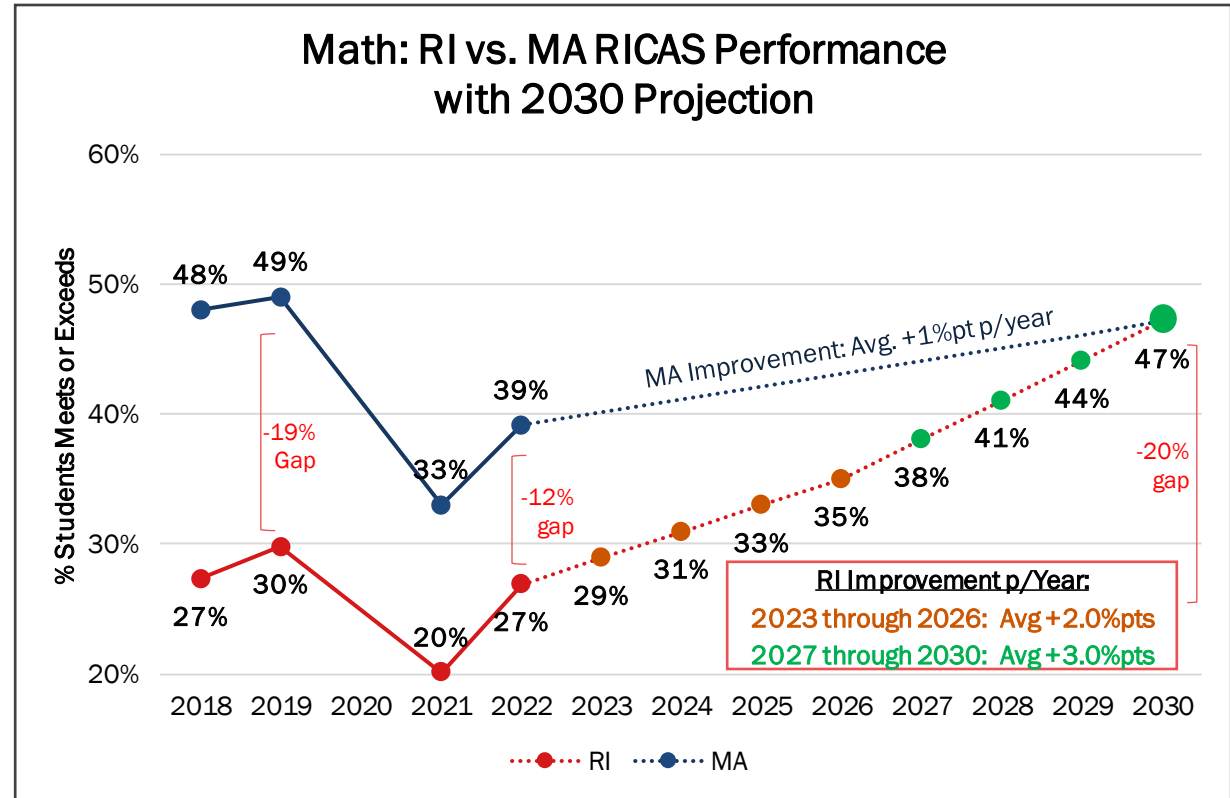
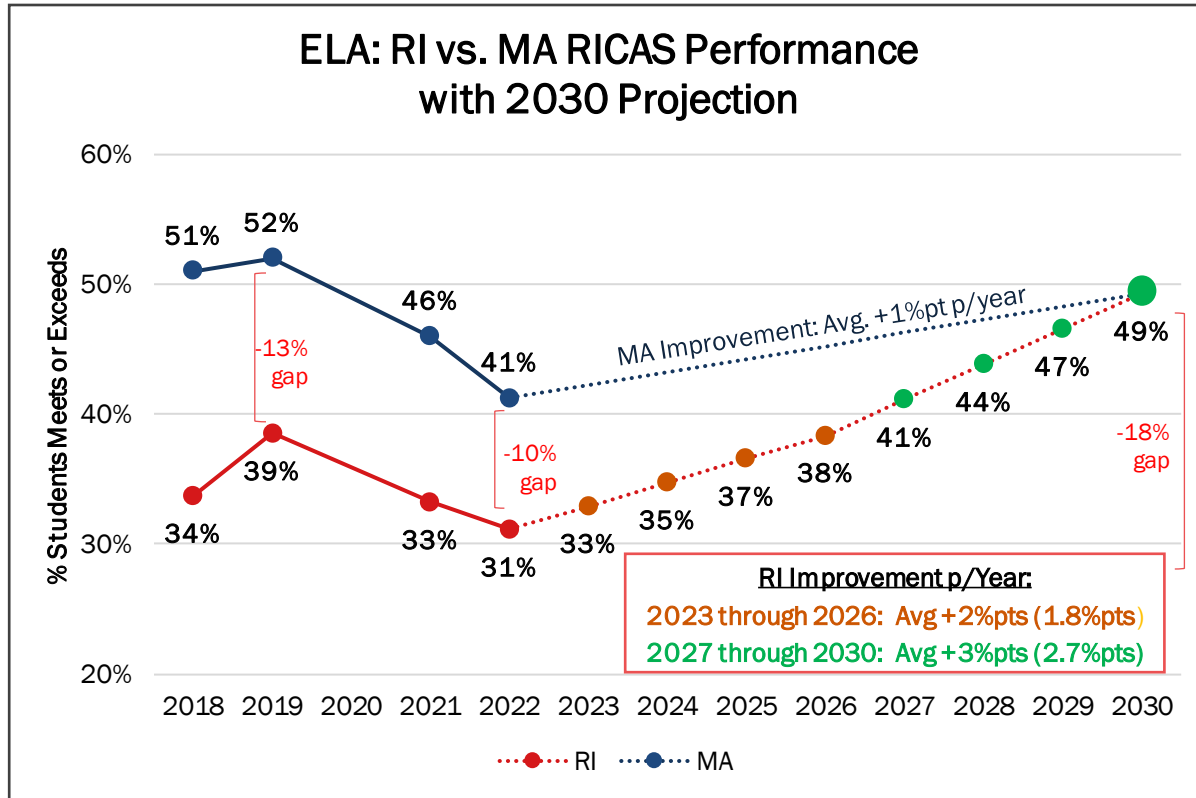


Same RI State and LEA Improvement

Apply the same improvement rates at the state level to all LEAs consistently, reflective of the fact that improvement is needed in all LEAs post-pandemic

2030 Goals: RICAS ELA & Math

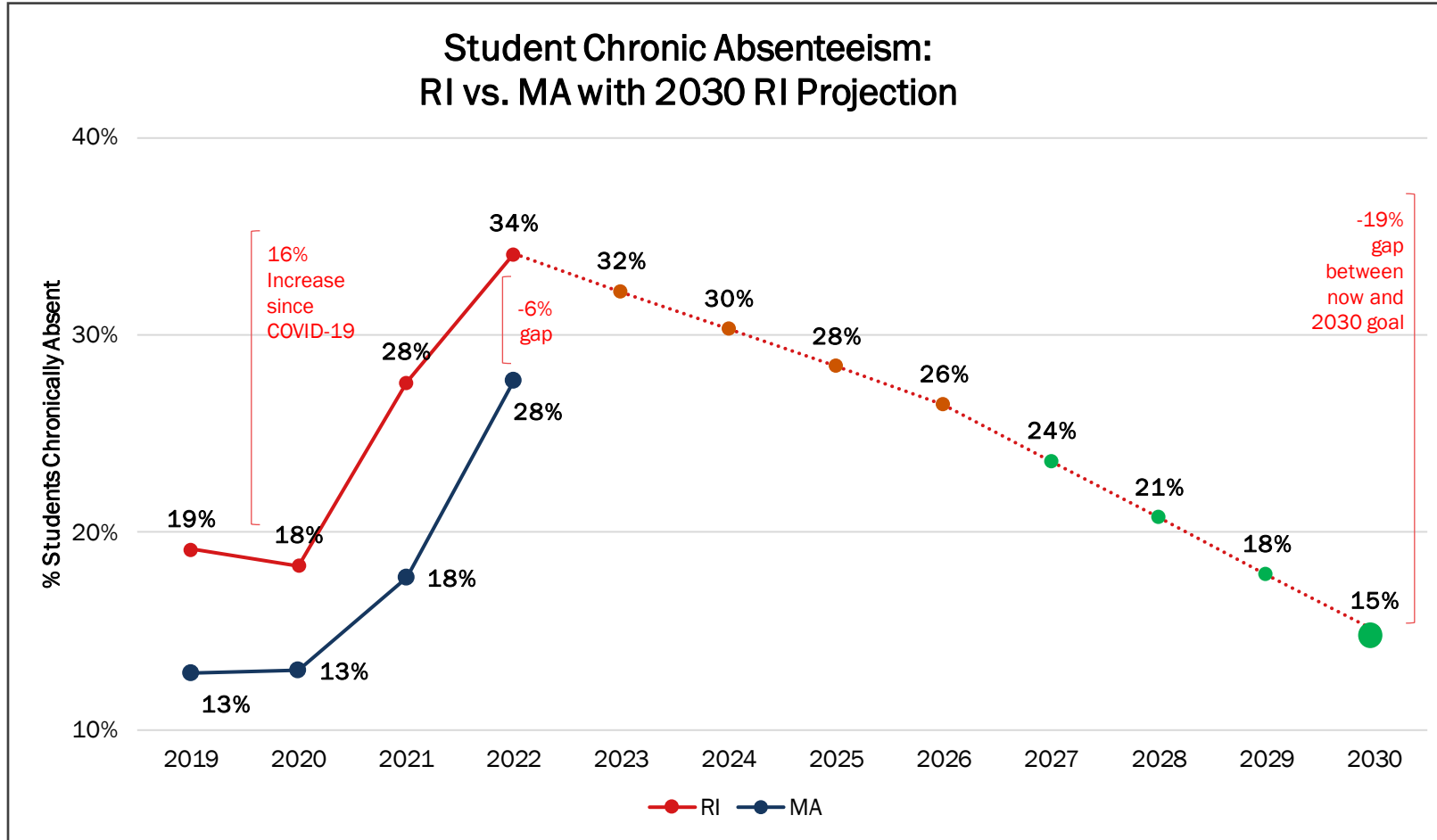
Preliminarily setting for 2030 goals projects RI needing to reach 49% of students meeting or exceeding expectations in ELA and 47% in math to meet and start to beat MA's performance levels by 2030 and perform similar to the highest performing state in the nation.

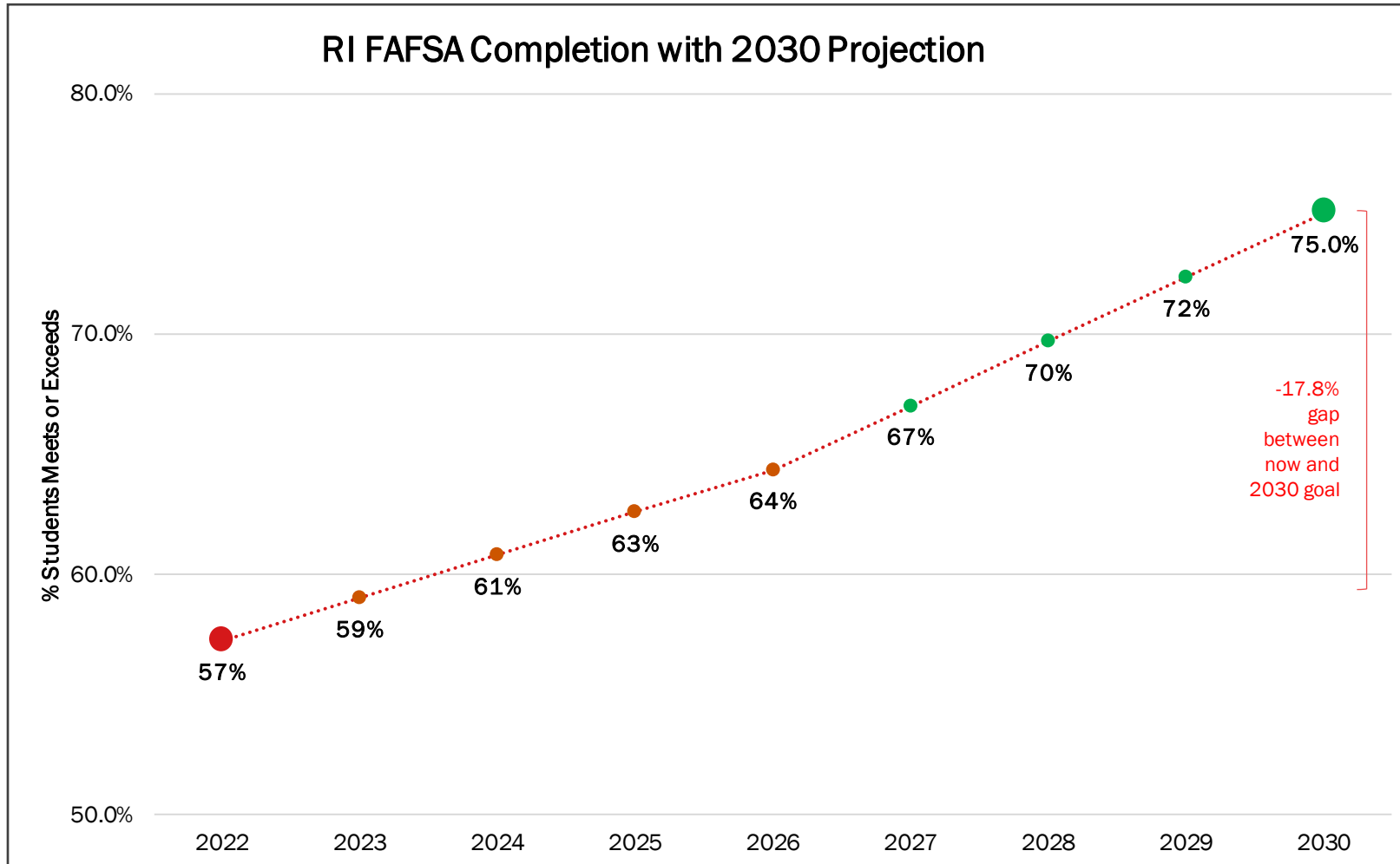
2030 Goals: Student Chronic Absenteeism



RI 2030 Goal: 15%

- Used similar ramping, linear approach
- Symbolically aligns to RIDE accountability rating for this metric
- 2023-26: ~2%pt decrease (1.9%)
- 2027-30: ~3%pt decrease (2.9%)

2030 Goals: FAFSA Completion



RI 2030 Goal: 75%

- Used similar ramp-up approach
- Will position RI as #1 state in the nation for FAFSA completion
- RI is already comparable / beating MA on FAFSA metric
- 2023-26: ~2%pt increase (1.8%)
- 2027-30: ~3%pt increase (2.7%)

Next Steps



- LEAs encouraged to include preliminary 2030 goals in their LEA / school strategic plans
- RIDE will re-evaluate preliminary 2030 goals after the release of 2023 performance data
- Stakeholders encouraged to use 2030 goals to help align around Learn365RI initiatives
