



Call for Entries: RI STEAM Month 2024 Logo Design Contest

Overview

The Rhode Island Department of Education and the Rhode Island STEAM Center will be celebrating STEAM Month 2024 in November! The purpose of RI STEAM Month is to celebrate opportunities that RI schools offer students in STEAM areas as well as highlight the importance of learning in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art+Design, and Mathematics areas. Rhode Island high school students are invited to design a logo and slogan to be used on promotional items and public announcements during RI STEAM Month 2024. Logos should include a slogan/quote and student-generated artwork that promotes STEAM Education for all students in Rhode Island.

Selection Criteria:

The artwork and slogan/tagline should:

- Be creative and original.
- Effectively capture the viewer's attention.
- Promote the innovative and collaborative nature of STEAM.
- Reflect the inclusion of all students in STEAM learning opportunities.
- Clearly promote Rhode Island STEAM Month 2024.
- Be reproducible with sharp, clean edges, free of smudges and extraneous marks.

Competition Rules

1. Use the selection criteria above to develop a positive visual message related to STEAM Education.
2. Artwork may be computer generated, hand drawn or a combination.
3. Any quotes used in the entry must have a name cited.
4. Entry must be 2-dimensional artwork that is original, no copywritten images can be used.
5. Original artwork must be submitted on 8.5" x 11" heavy weight paper, mounted on tagboard no larger than 11" x 14". Entry may use portrait or landscape orientation.
6. Digital pdf files of the artwork must be submitted, in both black & white and color.
7. Each contestant must neatly complete the Entry Form (below) and securely attach it to the back of the mounted artwork that is submitted.
8. **Entry materials (mounted original and 2 pdf files) must be received no later than Friday April 12th at 4:00 p.m.** Artwork may be mailed to RIDE or dropped off in person Monday through Friday between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. If mailed, entries must be mailed flat. *Do not fold, roll, or frame the paper.* Schools may mail student entries together or individually. Important dates and deadlines

- Submission deadline: **April 12, 2024, by 4:00 pm.** Entries will not be accepted after the deadline.
- Public viewing and online voting will occur in May.
- The winner will be notified in early June.
- Use of artwork in promotion of STEAM Month will be through Fall, 2024
- Original artwork will be available for return on or after July 1, 2024.
