School attendance is a powerful predictor of student outcomes. Rhode Island defines **chronic absenteeism** as missing 10% or more of school days during the year (about 2 days per month). If your child is not in school, they cannot learn!

Attending school regularly sets students up for success. Research shows that consistent attendance is linked to higher achievement, better engagement, a greater likelihood of graduating on time, and earning higher wages.

This school year, please maintain close contact with your child's school for additional support. By prioritizing attendance, families can help create a supportive learning environment and ensure that every child in Rhode Island has the opportunity for a bright future.
