- iii. *Int'l Brotherhood of Elec. Workers, Local 2323 v. Rhode Island Department of Education et al.*, C.A. No. 1:25-cv-00617 (D.R.I.), which is a request for a declaratory judgment concerning: (a) whether an independent public charter school is a "private employer," the employees of which have the right to strike under the National Labor Relations Act; and (b) whether the employees of such a school have been deprived of their right to a "prevailing wage" under R.I. Gen. Laws § 16-77.3-2(a); and
- iv. *City of Pawtucket and City of Cranston v. Council on Elementary and Secondary Education, et al.*, C.A. No. PC-2026-00649 (Prov. Cty. Superior Court), which is a request for a declaratory judgment holding that De La Comunidad Charter School is a "network" charter school that required "local written support" prior to the issuance of its charter.
