ACN Overview

- The All Course Network (ACN) is a RIDE initiative designed to offer credit-bearing academic opportunities to students in grades 7-12 outside of the traditional school day.
- Courses are offered in person, virtually, or through a hybrid model from course “Providers.” These providers can be Local Education Agencies (LEAs), Community-based organizations (CBOs), private Rhode Island postsecondary institutions and municipalities.
- Students pre-register for course selections on EnrollRI, RIDE’s student and family registration system.
- Course enrollment happens through a lottery process to ensure equitable access for all RI public school students.
 - Lottery for Summer, Fall and Yearlong Courses: Tuesday, June 2, 2026
 - Lottery for Spring 2027 courses: Tuesday, December 8 , 2026
- Once the lottery runs, open enrollment is available through the last day of the add drop period for each course. Rosters fill through a waitlist.



Course Enrollment

- Max number of courses a student can enroll in, regardless of number of school approvals:
 - *ONE* course in the Summer semester; *TWO* courses each in the Fall and Spring semesters. Yearlong courses count as 1 course for Fall and 1 course for Spring
- Approval process
 - School member approval is required for all courses.
- Add/Drop
 - Add/Drop window default is one calendar week for all courses (Day 1 + 6 days). **There may be exceptions to the default, especially for dual enrollment courses. Please review these dates with your students.**



Grades and Transcripts

- Grades

- Grades can be accessed two weeks after the course ends; they are visible on the school member dashboard and student dashboard
- Please share with your students:
 - Dropping a course is only an option during the add drop period. If they later decide they don't want to or are unable to take a course they need to withdraw from the course on their dashboards and will receive a course grade of W (Withdrawn). If they attend even one class and don't drop the course or withdraw, they'll receive an F in the course. Students aren't always aware of this and are surprised when they fail the course. Please remind them!
 - Dual enrollment course grades remain on their permanent postsecondary transcripts colleges see when reviewing their applications.

- Transcripts

- Unofficial ACN transcripts are accessible to students on their dashboards.
- Official transcripts for dual enrollment courses are provided free of charge to students by postsecondary institutions, at student request. Official transcripts aren't automatically provided to students.



LEA Responsibilities

LEAs sign a School Assurances document with RIDE to be a part of the All Course Network. School requirements include:

- Provide a school-level point of contact who approves students to take ACN courses
- Award high school credit to all students who successfully complete an ACN course
- Approve pre-registered students for courses that are academically appropriate, as applicable, *by each semester deadline*
- Share information about the All Course Network, including course options, benefits, and risks (permanent postsecondary transcript, W versus F grade)
- Support student pre-registration and enrollment
- Ensure ACN participation is aligned with Individual Learning Plans (ILPs), academic, career, and pathway goals
- Ensure equitable access to and equitable participation in the ACN, including special education students and MLLs. Course Providers receive supplemental funding for additional supports they provide to differently-abled and MLL students to ensure their success.
- Ensure that students are not restricted from participating in coursework as a result of district-level or school technology constraints
- Communicate, as needed, with Providers about student attendance and performance
- Participate in orientation and/or technical assistance (TA) sessions offered by RIDE



ACN Student & Family Responsibilities

- Create an EnrollRI account
- Browse available courses and decide which courses to prioritize for pre-registration.
 - Review prerequisites
 - Communicate with Providers about pre-enrollment requirements about course details and in general, any course specific questions. Provider contact details are available on the RIDE ACN website and in the course information in EnrollRI.
- Drop a course they don't intend to take before class begins or within the first week of class (add/drop period); or
- Withdraw from a course if the add drop period has ended.
- Share Unofficial ACN Transcript with school member contact in order to apply credit to current school transcript.

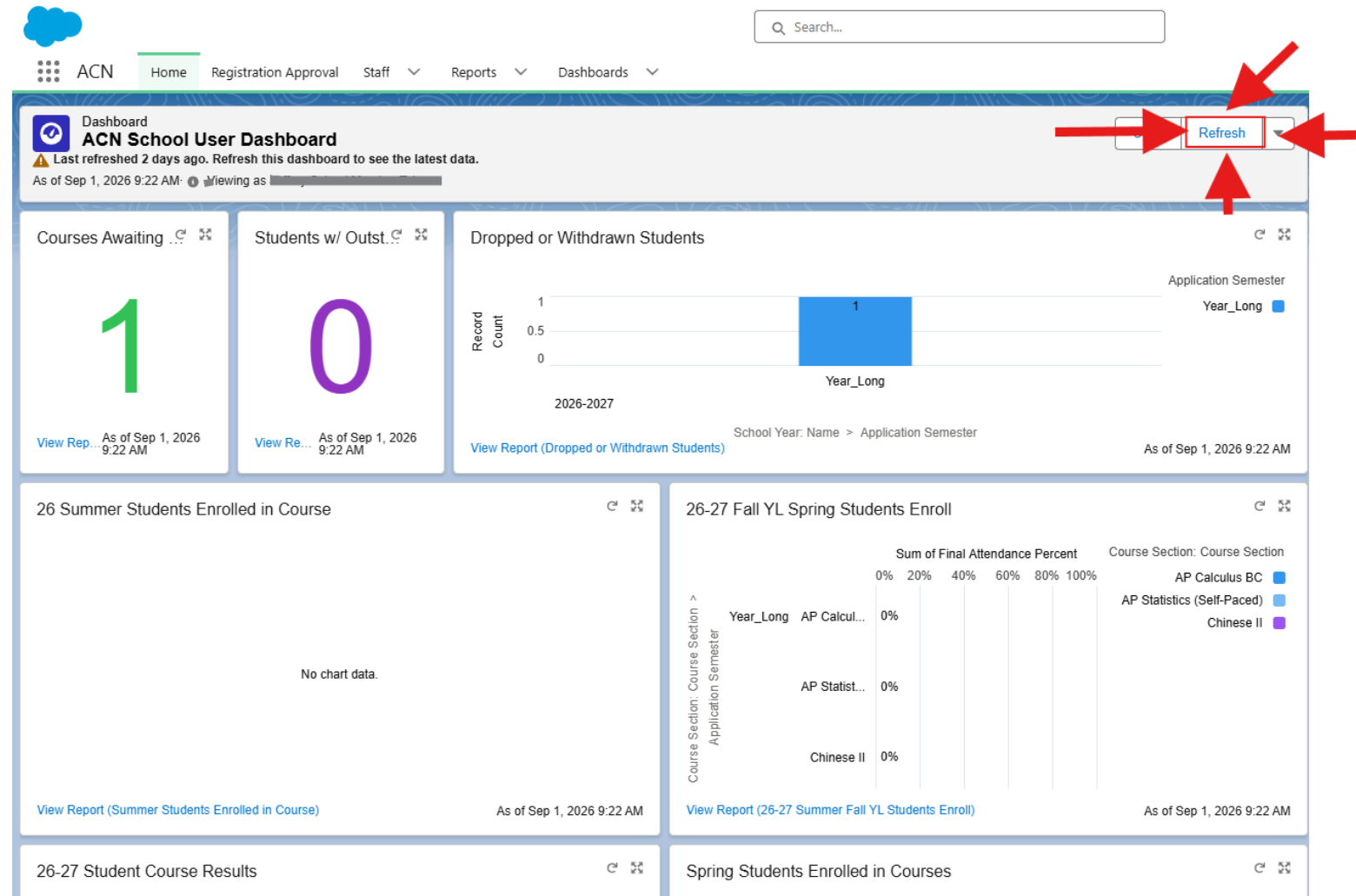

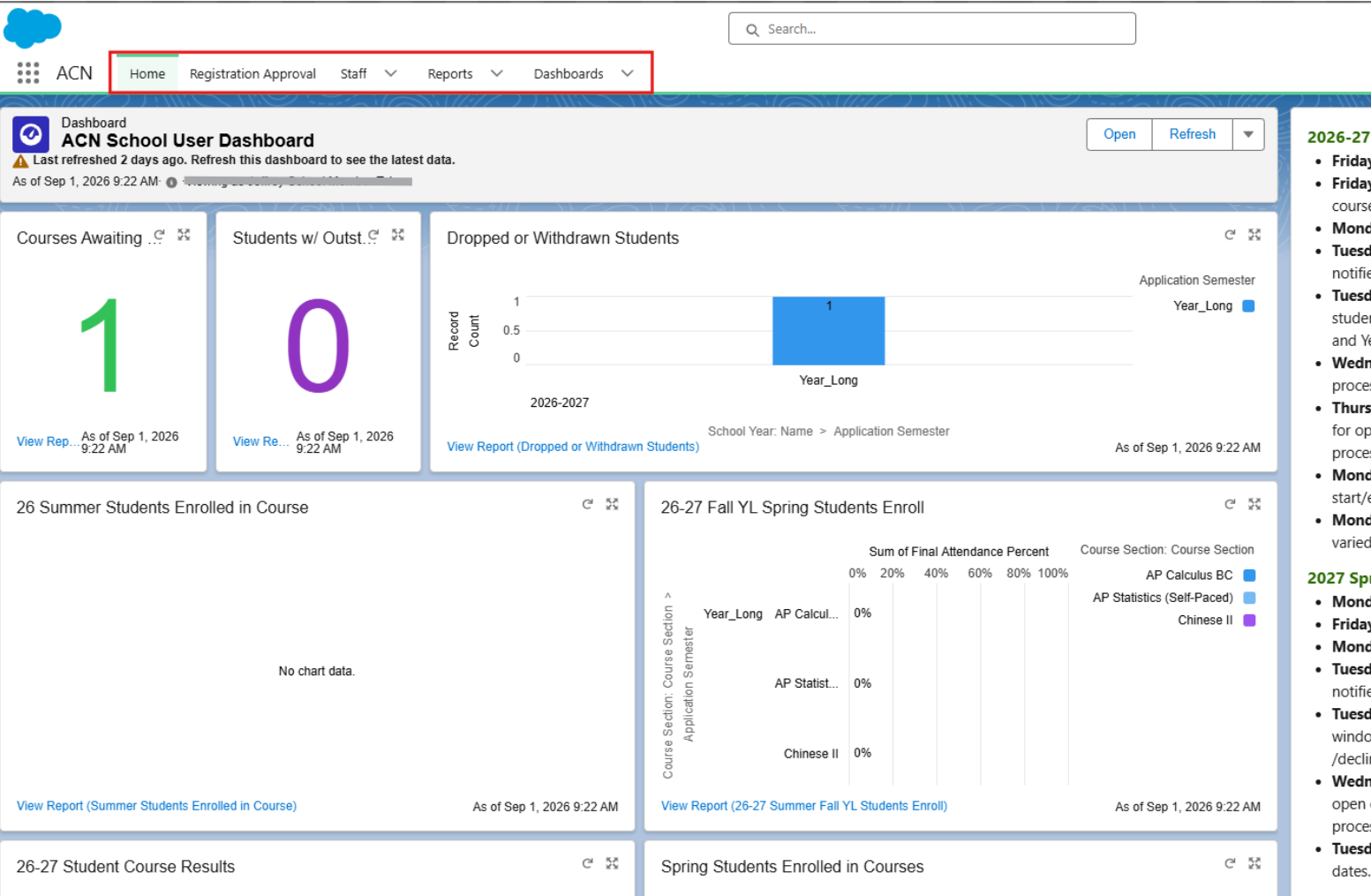
Accessing Your Student Data: Your Dashboard
