


# Summer 2021& 2021-2022 School Year All Course Network (ACN): How to Create an EnrollRI Account and Register for Courses (Grades K-7)

Parents/guardians of students in grades K-7 should create an account and register their child for ACN courses using EnrollRI. Parents who have used EnrollRI for the charter school common application can use the same email/phone to log in here.

1. Beginning May 3, 2021, visit [EnrollRI.org/acn](https://enrollri.org/acn), and click on “Create an Account.”
  - a. Select “Parent/Guardian” from the drop-down menu and fill in your information.
  - b. If you do not have access to a phone that can receive text messages, you must select “email” as the verification method.



2. After creating and verifying your account, you will be logged in to the system. To access your account in future visits, return to the home screen and insert the email or phone number associated with the account and click “log in.”
  - a. EnrollRI is “passwordless,” so users just insert a one-time code from their phone or email and don’t have to remember a password to access their account.
3. From the parent dashboard, parents can add K-7 students to their account as needed by clicking “add student”. Fill in “student information” for each student.
  - a. Fields with the red lines are required.
  - b. This information can be edited at any time from their student dashboard.

4. To access course information for each student, click on “go to student dashboard.” To browse and register for courses, select “add course.”
  - a. Available courses will appear on the selection page based on the student’s information. Click the “info” icon next to the course for details on meeting times, credits, etc.
  - b. **Students can pre-register for up to 8 courses for the summer session and 6 courses each for the fall, spring and year-long sessions; however, each student can only enroll in up to the following courses per semester:**
    - i. **Summer: 1 credit-bearing course (for a total of four courses)**
    - ii. **Fall: 2 courses**
    - iii. **Spring: 2 courses**
    - iv. **Year-long courses count as 1 course for Fall and Spring**
  - c. Courses that do not have seats available will show up as “full,” and can be selected for a student’s waitlist.
  - d. To pre-register for a course with prerequisites, parents must confirm that their students meet the requirements.

**Prerequisite Description**  
Students must demonstrate advanced ballet skills through a recommendation from a current ballet teacher and a video audition. The video audition can be done at home or in a studio and does not need advanced equipment or editing beyond what is easily accessible on a cell phone or computer. The video must include the following: at the barre - tendu, rond de jambe, fondu, and grand battement; at center - adagio and petit allegro; on pointe - echappes, and pirouettes. Audition videos and teacher recommendations should be emailed to Valerie Cookson-Botto at discover@festivalballetprovidence.org prior to January 11, 2021. Additionally, students must have proper ballet attire, as well as ballet technique and pointe shoes (for girls).

- All information entered on the pre-registration form displays on a summary. This page can be printed. Once the terms and conditions are accepted, a copy of this information is also sent to the email address reflected on the summary.

- If a student is on the waitlist for a course and a spot opens up, they will receive an email notification that they are enrolled. If an enrollment offer would put the student over the

maximum number of courses allowed (2 per semester), they then have 2 days to log into the system and accept or decline the offer before the offer expires.

- a. *Note: If students are enrolled in 2 courses and are offered a spot in another course, they must withdraw from one of their previously-enrolled courses.*
