
RIDE Portal – Student Data Portal Application User's Guide

Best Practices for Selecting Your Testing Windows

- 1. Determine how many staff you will need before selecting your testing window.
- 2. Use as much of the state testing window as possible. Even if your school testing window is over, if you're within the state assessment window, you can continue testing.
- 3. Plan to test 100% of students in each content area.
- 4. Start as early in the state primary testing window as possible.
- 5. Adhere to the state testing window for make-up testing.



- RIDE uses roles in the master directory to create accounts in each test platform and update the assessment listsery.
- Updating your information requires two steps:
 - 1. Please email any changes to the test coordinator role to assessment@ride.ri.gov.
 - 2. Inform your data manager of changes to the Master Directory. Make sure the following roles are assigned, even if the title is something different:
 - District Test Coordinator
 - School Test Coordinator
 - Principal
 - Data Manager
 - Technology Coordinator/Manager
 - SSD Coordinator (for schools administering SAT and PSAT 10)
- Select one primary role for each person. Selecting multiple primary roles results in duplicate entries in the directory.

The New Digital SAT/PSAT

- State Assessment SAT and PSAT 10 testing window has been lengthened:
 - April 1-12 PRIMARY TESTING April 22-26 MAKEUP TESTING
 - Students will be taking the assessment on the BlueBook app
 - There are far more universal tools built into the Bluebook test application which can reduce accommodation requests
 - NEW **Digital** test for Spring 2024
 - Previous SAT/PSAT testing was the "paper test" being accessed on the computer
 - Students requiring a paper test will be taking the original linear paper test
 - Two stage adaptive test
 - Students will take 2 modules in each content:
 - Module 1 will determine the "route" of module 2
 - Students are not aware of the transition from module 1 to module 2
 - Every student will have a unique test



The New Digital SAT/PSAT

- Test Day Toolkit (TDTK) is replacing TIDE
- SSD Online will talk to TDTK and accommodations will automatically be linked
- Testing time for students has significantly decreased
- Number of questions has decreased
- Calculator is now allowable on entire test and does not require an accommodation request
- Flexibility to allow for multi grade testing rooms if necessary
- New test coordinators should contact College Board to ensure all important information is received <u>State Testing School Contact Update Form (smartsheet.com)</u>
- Educators who have children taking either the SAT or the PSAT this year:
